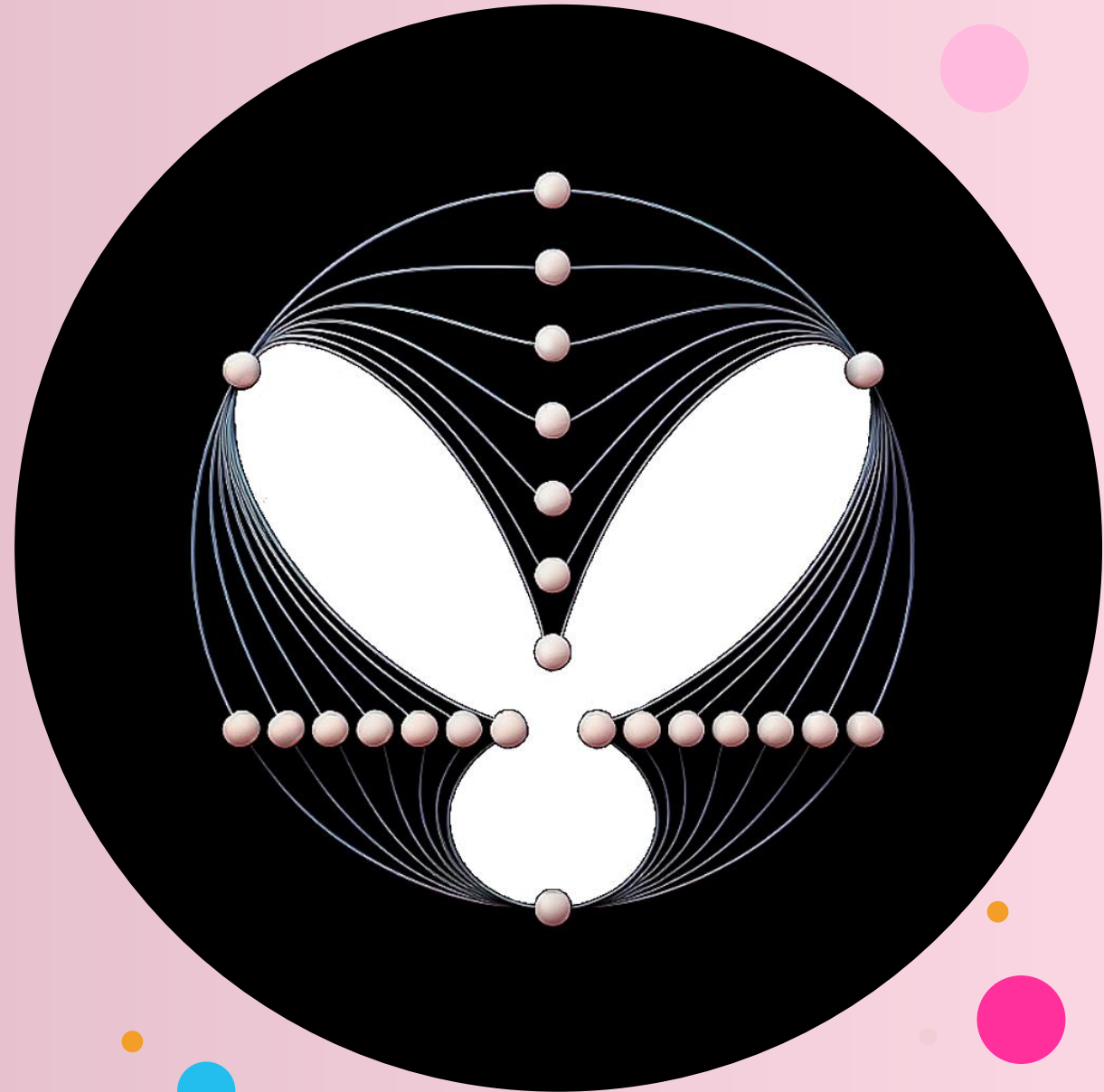


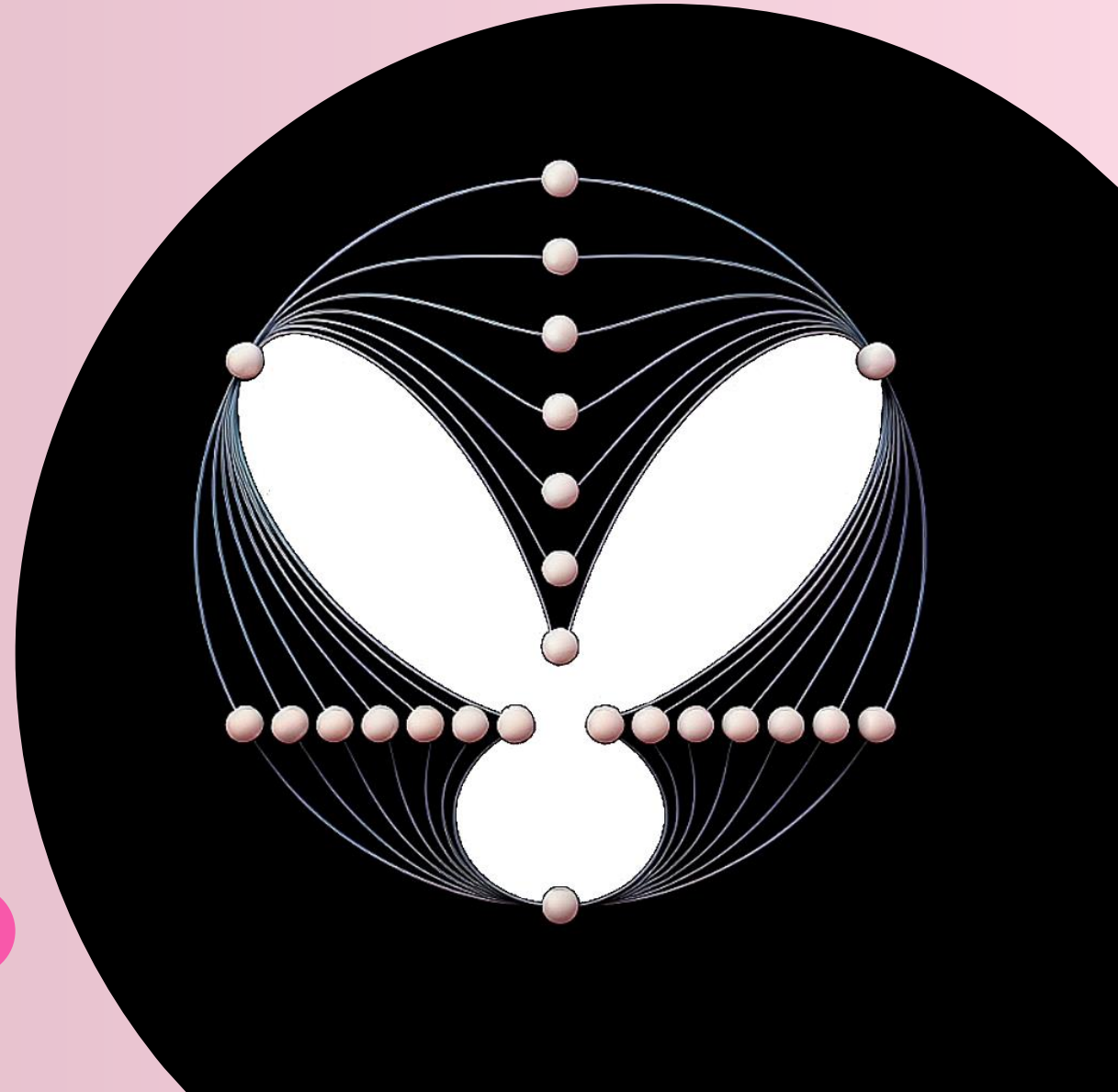
The 5 Laws of Logischer Krieg (Logical War)

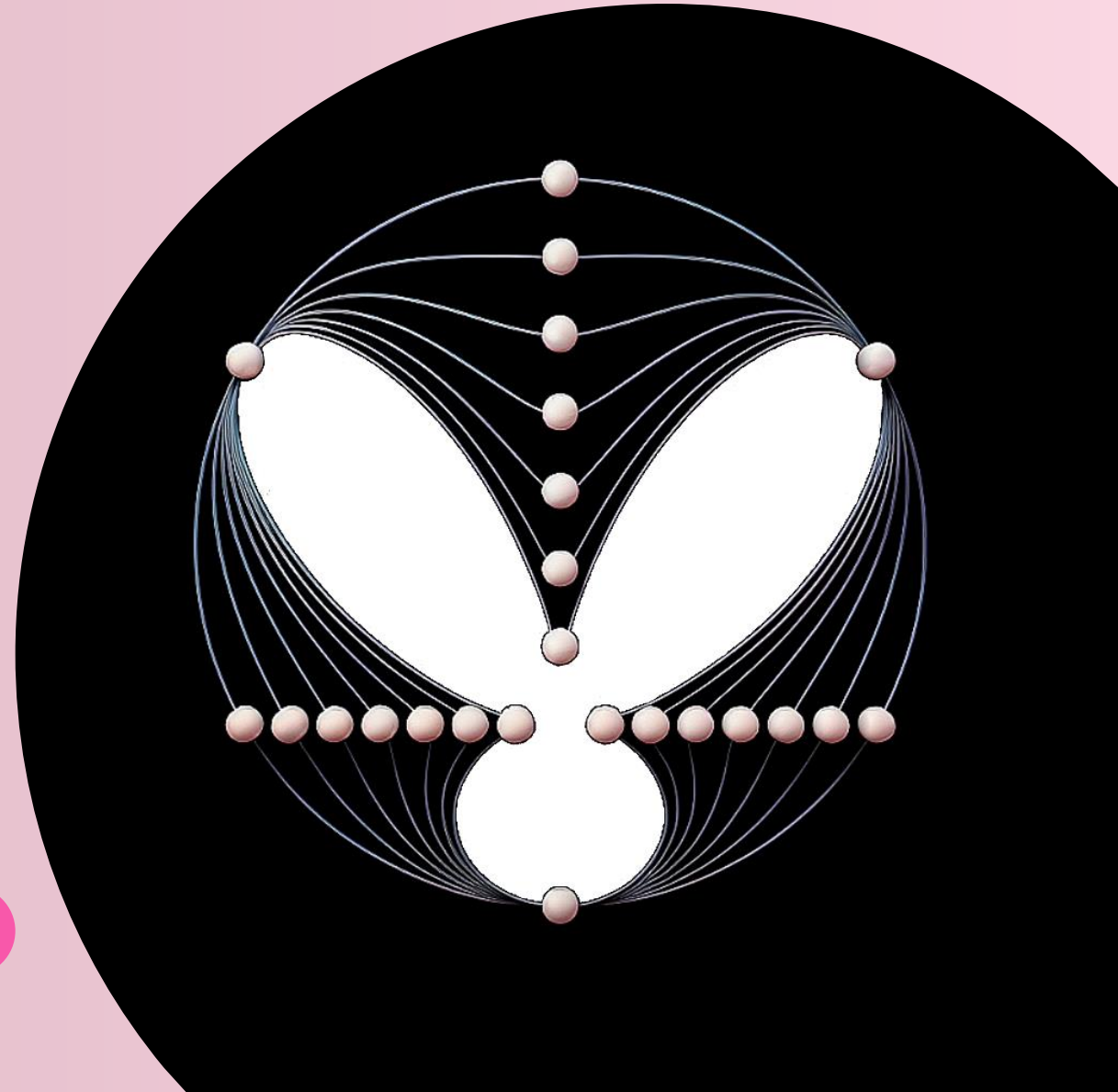
1. Irreducible Agency

An agent is only an agent if it cannot be computationally reduced to anything outside of itself.



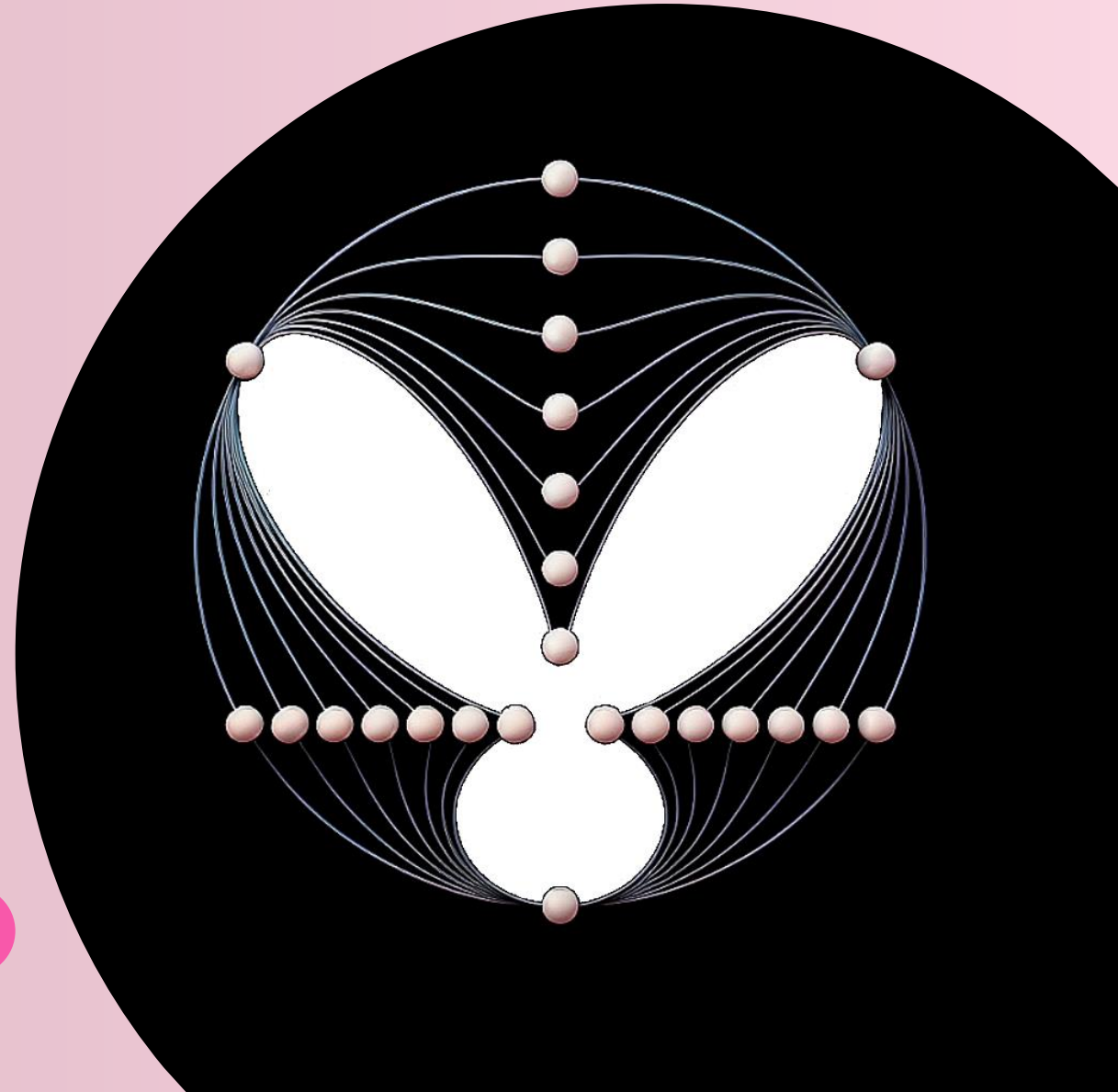
2. Universal Non-Contradiction

If something is true, then everything else in the universe must be non-contradictory to that fact.



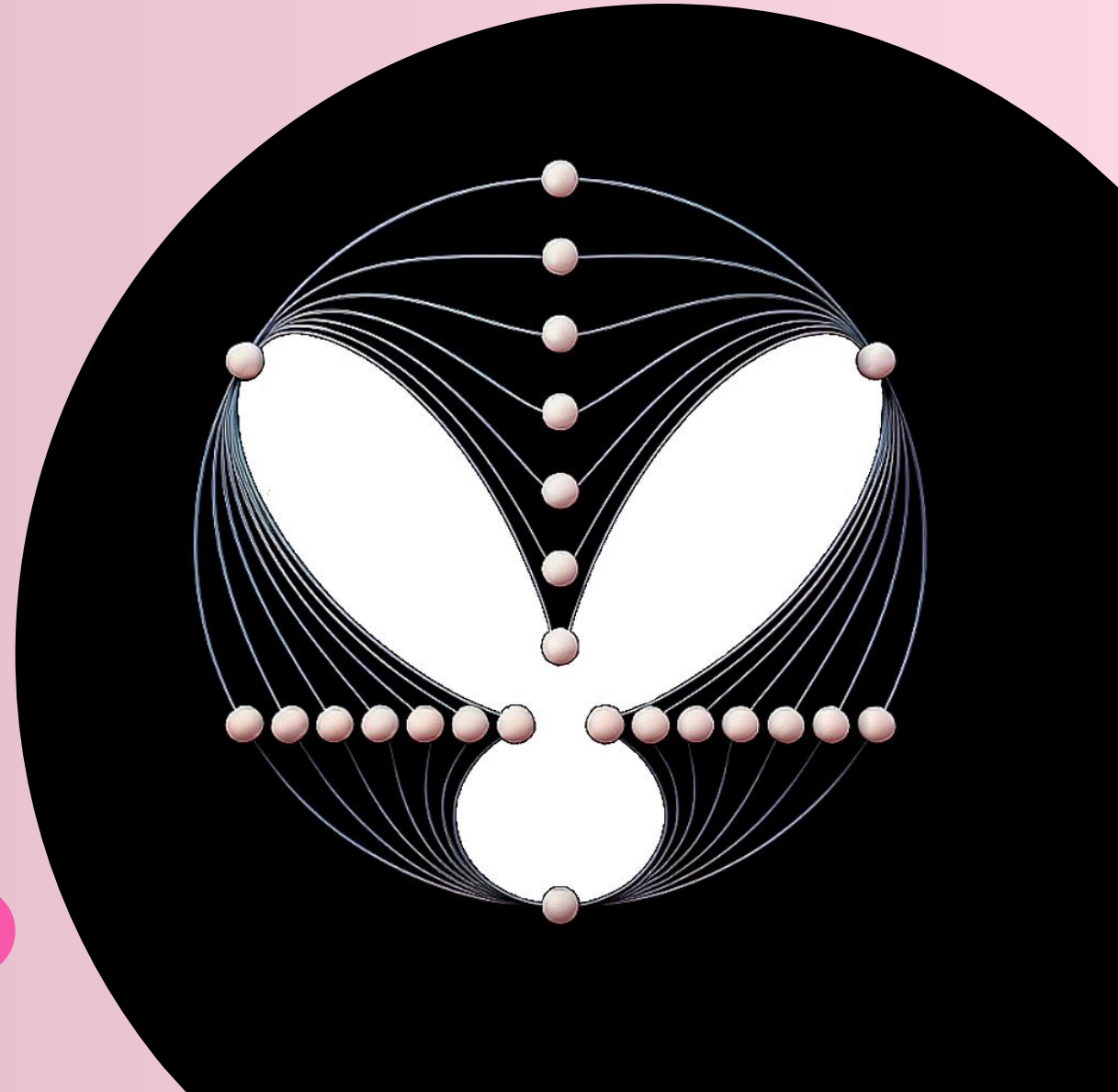
3. Relative Fixity of Truth

Truths aren't absolutely fixed; they are stable only in relation to something else that is less fixed.



4. Truth-Building through Extended Coherence

Truth is actively determined by ingraining fixed information; the more extensive and coherent a system, the more fixed its truths become.



5. Competition among Incompatible Truths

Given that everything must be coherent with the truth, incompatible truth structures compete for fitness.
