## Submarine Cables at Risk of Cyber-Attacks

Submarine communication cables are becoming a target for cyber-threat actors, with incidents potentially causing global internet disruption. Geopolitical developments, such as the Russia-Ukraine conflict, China's actions towards Taiwan, and US-China tensions, are likely to drive the risk environment. These cables transmit 99% of intercontinental internet traffic and carry sensitive government communications.
