New Exploit for VMware SSH Auth Bypass

Proof-of-concept exploit code has been released for a critical SSH authentication bypass vulnerability in VMware's Aria Operations for Networks analysis tool. The flaw was found by security analysts at ProjectDiscovery Research and patched by VMware on Wednesday with the release of version 6.11.
