Ransomware attack at Semikron

A statement by the semiconductor manufacturer detailed the ransomware attack which led to partial encryption of the system after hackers attempted to steal data. The hackers are allegedly blackmailing the company and threatening to leak data that the company had allegedly stolen. The attack is thought to be an LV Ransomware attack.



What is an LV Ransomware Attack?

LV ransomware is timestamped as being compiled on 15th of June 2020, it's suggested that it's a modified version of REvil, this means that the code has likely been stolen or sold. REvil is a RaaS (ransomware-as-a-service) operation which is used to gain large amounts of money from organisations. The ransomware is spread by affiliates who gain access to

the targets network and deploy the ransomware.
