ATAYA KASER MEMORIAL Spring 2021 SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

Safe Haven Baby Boxes and the Ataya Kaser Memorial Scholarship Committee members seek to reward high school and college students who are committed to using their gifts and talents to demonstrate awareness and to take proactive steps to raise awareness of Safe Haven Laws throughout the United States.

The Ataya Kaser Memorial Scholarship Fund (Foundation) will be awarding one (1) \$4,000 scholarships to eligible high school seniors and/or eligible undergraduate college students for college tuition during the next academic school year. The scholarships will be awarded after completion of the Spring 2021 semester of high school or college to support tuition and/or course fees for the Fall 2021 college academic session. Full time students will be awarded the full amount to be used for the Fall 2021 academic session. Part time students will be awarded \$2,000 for the Fall 2021 academic session and \$2,000 for the Spring 2022 academic session. The number of scholarships and amount awarded is based upon the available funding and confirmed during each application period. Winners will be notified no later than March 15, 2021 and will be announced on March 31, 2021.

Please Note: If the funding available to students from the Ataya Kaser Memorial scholarship fund is not sufficient, future awards might be adjusted as necessary during the next application period. Every effort will be made to continue the level of funding of scholarships.

To be eligible, students must meet the following minimum requirements:

1. Submit all documents listed on or before January 31, 2021.
2. Be a high school senior or undergraduate level student at the time of application submission.
3. Have the ability to demonstrate your community commitment through academic performance, involvement in school activities, military service, and/or job experience.
4. Have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher in the last academic school year.

The scholarship will be awarded to one (1) student after the following criteria have been met:

- Completion of Spring 2021 semester of high school or college.
- Submission of high school or college transcript from Spring 2021 semester.
- All information and requirements outlined in this application are met.

With this application please include the following:

- Completed application form with required signatures.
- High School transcripts showing at least a 3.0 unweighted GPA and completion of Fall 2020 semester. Copies of original transcripts are acceptable.

- A letter of recommendation from one of the references listed in the application.

Note:

Applications received by the Ataya Kaser Memorial Scholarship Committee after January 31, 2021 will not be reviewed. Applications that are missing materials or do not meet minimum requirements will not be reviewed.

ESSAY INSTRUCTIONS

Choose a state that currently does not have any Safe Haven Baby Boxes and write about why you believe this state should have them. What is the current Safe Haven law for the chosen state? What are some other creative methods for educating communities in this state and for promoting awareness of the Safe Haven law?
