This budget will raise more total property tax revenue than last year's budget by \$27,818, which is a 3.61% increase from last year's budget, and of that amount \$20,284 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year. The debt obligation secured by property taxes is \$0.00 - Discuss and Take Action

**B. Adoption of 2021 Tax Rate, Ordinance 2109 –
AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR USE AND
SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF ST.
HEDWIG, TEXAS FOR THE 2021 TAX YEAR, AND PROVIDING WHEN
TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME
DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID**

The Proposed 2021 Tax Rate is \$0.463578 per \$100 valuation. This proposed tax rate is the same rate as last year, is greater than the No-New-Revenue Tax Rate, and will raise \$27,818 more in property tax revenue for the City from the same properties in both the 2020 and 2021 tax year - Discuss and Take Action


