AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF ST. HEDWIG, TEXAS FOR THE 2020 TAX YEAR, AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID

The Proposed 2020 Tax Rate is \$0.463578 per \$100 valuation. This proposed tax rate is equal to the No-New-Revenue Tax Rate and will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the City from the same properties in both the 2019 and 2020 tax year - Discuss and Take Action
