Budget and Tax Rate Public Hearing

September 9, 2021

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Mayor Dee Grimm called the Public Hearing to order at 7:03 pm.

2. ROLL CALL AND ESTABLISH A QUORUM

PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing to allow for citizens' comments and input on the following:

Fiscal Year 2021-2022 City Budget

This budget will raise more total property tax revenue than last year's budget by \$27,818, which is a 3.61% increase from last year's budget, and of that amount \$20,284 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year. The debt obligation secured by property taxes is \$0.00

PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing to allow for citizens' comments and input on the following:

2021 Tax Rate

The Proposed 2021 Tax Rate is \$0.463578 per \$100 valuation.
The No-New Revenue Tax Rate is \$0.452995 per \$100 valuation
The Voter-Approval Tax Rate is \$0.496229 per \$100 valuation

This proposed tax rate, is the same tax rate as last year, but is greater than the No-New-Revenue Tax Rate, and will raise \$27,818 more in property tax revenue for the City from the same properties in both the 2020 and 2021 tax year
