SIGNIFICANT EVENTS AND CRITICAL INFORMATION

Emergency Management: BCOEM continues to monitor the weather conditions; coordinating opening seven (7) cooling centers in ESD 2 at 2096 Talley Road, ESD 3 at 23103 Bulverde Road, ESD 5 at 7120 East Sixth Street in Somerset, ESD 8 at 20825 Babcock Road, ESD 10 at 9100 S. Loop 1604 E., ESD 12 at 14229 FM 1346 in Saint Hedwig, and the Fire Marshal's Office at 9810 Southton Road which will be open from 12:00 pm to 9:00 pm; supplies of ice and water have been delivered; signage is prepared for the facilities with hours of operation and a contact list for the on-site shelter manager BCOEM is monitoring the ERCOT Supply & Demand reports and information from CPS Energy.

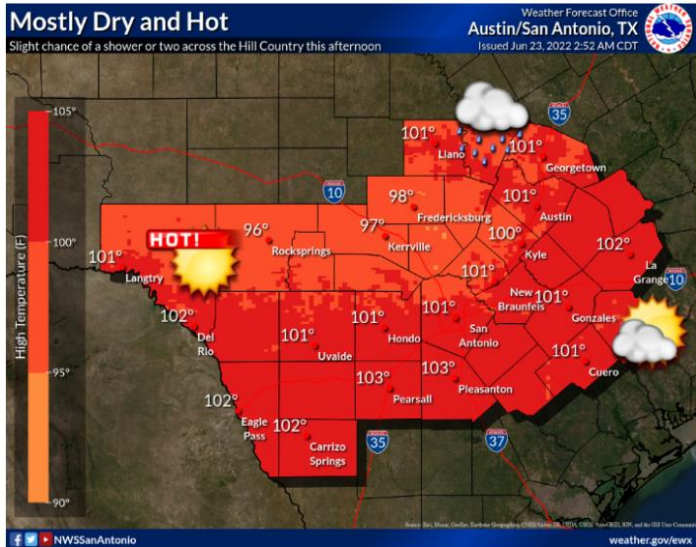
Cooling Centers: Staffing is comprised of BCFS staff and the FMO location is being staffed by Bexar County Fire Marshals supplemented by Bexar County OEM staff. Bexar County OEM has identified 3 shelter locations in efforts to provide contingency cooling locations and/or to provide overnight accommodations should the need arise. An additional shelter is in the process of being identified to provide coverage for all four precincts for Bexar County.

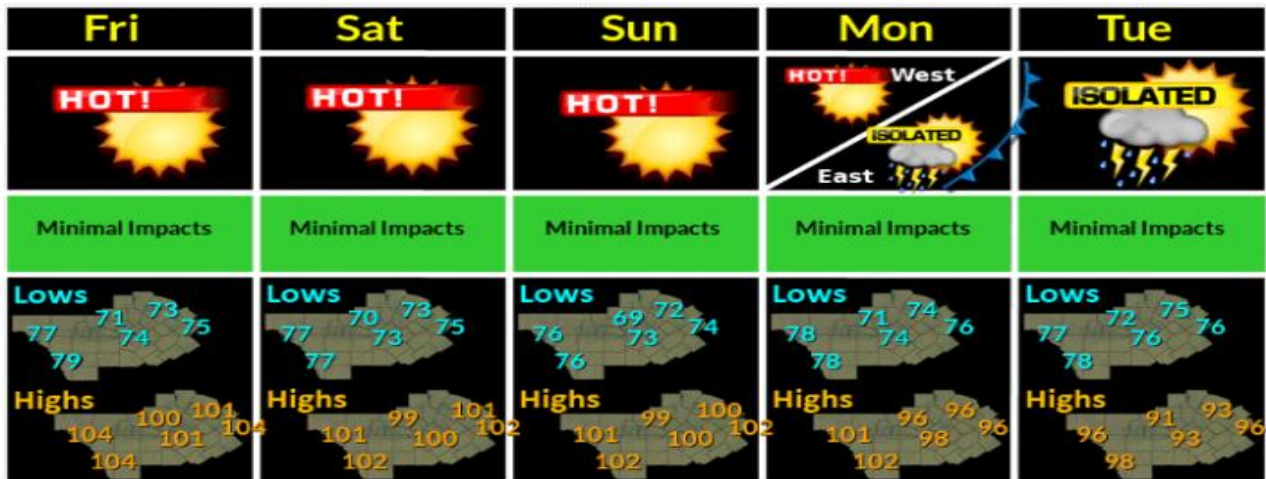

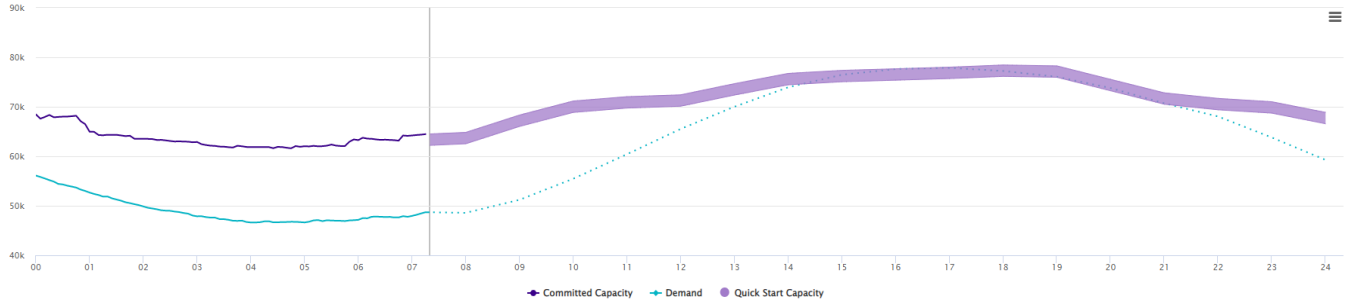


POWER SUPPLY AND DEMAND
