

STANDING RULES

1. Standing rules are adopted or suspended by a majority vote of the General Membership. They may be amended or repealed by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those members present, without notice or a majority vote if previous notice is given.
2. All members shall cooperate and comply with the rules and regulations established by the Legends Golf Course at Temeku Hills. Dress Code while playing golf is established by the Course and must be adhered to by all THMGC members.
3. The Tournament Chairman shall schedule Weekly Tournaments each Wednesday. All attending, active members with an established handicap may participate in and pay for Weekly Tournaments. Weekly Green Fees shall be established by negotiation with the Legends Golf Course Management. Weekly prize fund buy-ins shall be \$10.00 per week. (Amended by Membership Vote January 2022).
4. Tee times will be the usual weekly format starting with a shotgun start at 8:00A.M (9:00 AM during the winter). Whenever tee times or the number of players are inconvenient for the Golf Course, or special scheduling of tournaments is required, these times will be adapted to accommodate.
5. The Tournament Chairman will have sign-up sheets available each Wednesday for the following Wednesday's game. Any subsequent changes shall be made with the tournament Chairman. Members must call the Tournament Chairman to sign-up or any board member to cancel play.
6. A non-mandatory hole-in-one fund is established by the THMGC at a cost of \$5.00 per member. The fund shall remain intact until such time as a participating member scores a hole-in-one during a THMGC Tournament. If during any one tournament two or more participating members score a hole-in-one, the fund shall be divided equally among them. (Amended by membership vote)

7. At least two scorecards must be kept in each foursome. One completed scorecard will be submitted at the end of the round, signed by at least two players. Any discrepancy in the scorecard after it is submitted shall be solved by current USGA rules.
8. Each member is responsible for posting his score after play. If the computer is down, the Handicap Chairman shall be responsible for posting that day's scores.
9. All golf rounds where at least 13 holes have been played, whether at home or away, must be posted for handicap purposes. A net par will be posted for all holes not played. The Handicap Chairman may adjust the handicap of any member who fails to post his score. Posting must be compliance with USGA and SCGA rules.
10. THMGC will conduct four major tournaments each year (1) President's Cup (2) the Legends Cup (3) the Club Championship and (4) the Highland Cup. To be eligible to play in a major tournament, a member must have an established handicap and must have played in at least four THMGC events in the preceding 90 days of is an active member of a Travel Team. The Board of Directors may waive these requirements in cases of illness, injury, or extended absence from the area. (Amended by Vote 2-13).
11. Each member shall be responsible for notifying the Tournament Chairman by noon Monday preceding play on a Wednesday Monthly Tournament if he will or cannot be participating in Wednesday Tournament play.
12. The Board of Directors of the THMGC has the authority to change or amend existing by-laws if required by directive from SCGA. Otherwise, no change to the by-laws will be made without the vote and concurrence of the General Membership. Any proposed changes must be announced on the Website and posted on the Men's Club Bulletin Board at least 30 days before any vote is taken.. (added by vote September 2004)
