She serves on the board of her alma mater, Houston Graduate School of Theology, and on advisory boards for Rice University's Religion and Public Life Program and re:MINDHouston. She has held a training position at the Jung Center at the Mind Body Spirit Institute for many years and will continue her Learning to be Immersive series in 2023.

Juanita cofoundedBread of Life, Inc. a nonprofit corporation, with her husbandRudy in 1992 and began serving meals to the homeless in the sanctuary at St. John's. Juanita most recently teamed up with Tina Knowles Lawson and Beyoncé to help forty thousand flood victims recover in the wake of Hurricane Harvey in Houston. In addition to addressing issues of health and disaster relief, Juanita launched the Temenos Community Development Corporationin 2006, which has completed sixty million dollars in housing development projects for the previously homeless in downtown Houston. She also founded The Art Project-Houston to empower the city's homeless to become hope-filled painters and artisans who craft their own livelihood and create lives filled with new possibilities.

She has written two books that focus on teaching about therelationship with yourself and genuine kindness.








Learning To Be: Finding Your Center After The Bottom Falls Out
