- Wastewater and trash disposal plan TBD
- Fire safety: approved fire extinguisher on-site; all cooking equipment must meet fire codes.
- Generators must be placed on stable, level surfaces, properly grounded, and meet fire/safety codes.
- Quiet/generator rules: generators must be quiet-model and operated to minimize disruption; fuel storage must comply with safety regulations.

Sales & Taxes

- Vendors are responsible for collecting/remitting applicable sales tax and required permits.

Cancellation

- Cancellation policy: full refund only if event is canceled by organizer
