






Old Houses of St George Oct 28th Monthly Program

Yuletide in St George Nov 26th and 27th

The St George peninsula will be bustling on the Friday and Saturday following Thanksgiving. The Old Library Museum will be open both days for you to see some new displays and to pick up some Xmas gifts for your history buff!! Besides the reprint of Smalley's "*History of St George, Maine*", we also have copies of "*The Voyage of Archangell*", the story of Waymouth's voyage here in 1605; "*The St George Peninsula*" by Tammy Willey; and "*Cemetery Inscriptions of St George, Maine*" by S Sullivan & R Welsch. Also, some local postcards, maps, mugs, etc.



1898 Photos of St George Homes, Stores & Businesses

In 1898 it appears that a photographer went through the St George peninsula taking photos of homes and businesses, most of them with the owners and occupants standing outside. The collection of 100+ glass negatives of these photos exist today, along with some printed photos.

Past Perfect Museum Collection Software

Several weeks ago, the St George Historical Society purchased the Starter version of this widely used collection management software. It will allow us to catalog the items that have been either given to us or that people have allowed us to scan or copy. The software allows us to provide information about the item, plus attach an image. Once there are enough of the items cataloged, we will purchase the public access part of the software that will allow the public to search and view what is in our collection. If you'd like to see what we will eventually be capable of, check out the Penobscot Marine Museum's Online Collections Database to see how it works - Penobscot Marine Museum : Online Collections (pastperfectonline.com).

After a week of entering items, we have 412 images in the software, mostly photos from the Andrew Robinson House collection. In our photo archives we currently have about 2000 images in 67 various collections. And, we have had a lot of items already donated that need scanning – and there are more coming in every week!
