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Explanation of Grading of Findings

- 'Deficiency' (**D nn**) means a deficiency other than a serious deficiency and is an observed situation where objective evidence indicates that the SRPS is not in conformity with the MLC, 2006 or the relevant requirements of the flag State. **"Date of Completion"** indicates the date by which the SRPS should submit evidence of the necessary corrections to Lloyd's Register.
- 'Observation' (**O**) means a statement of fact made during an assessment substantiated by objective evidence. It may also be an identified situation which may lead to a deficiency in the future if no action is taken.
