When Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus, the crowd became a barrier. Because he was short, the people in front kept him from seeing the Savior. 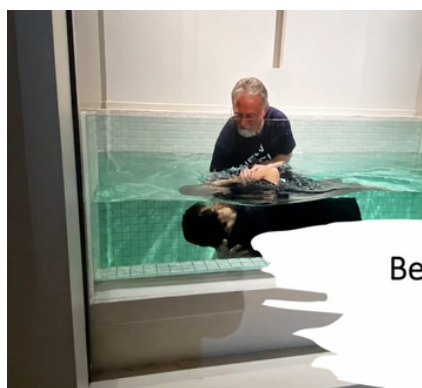
