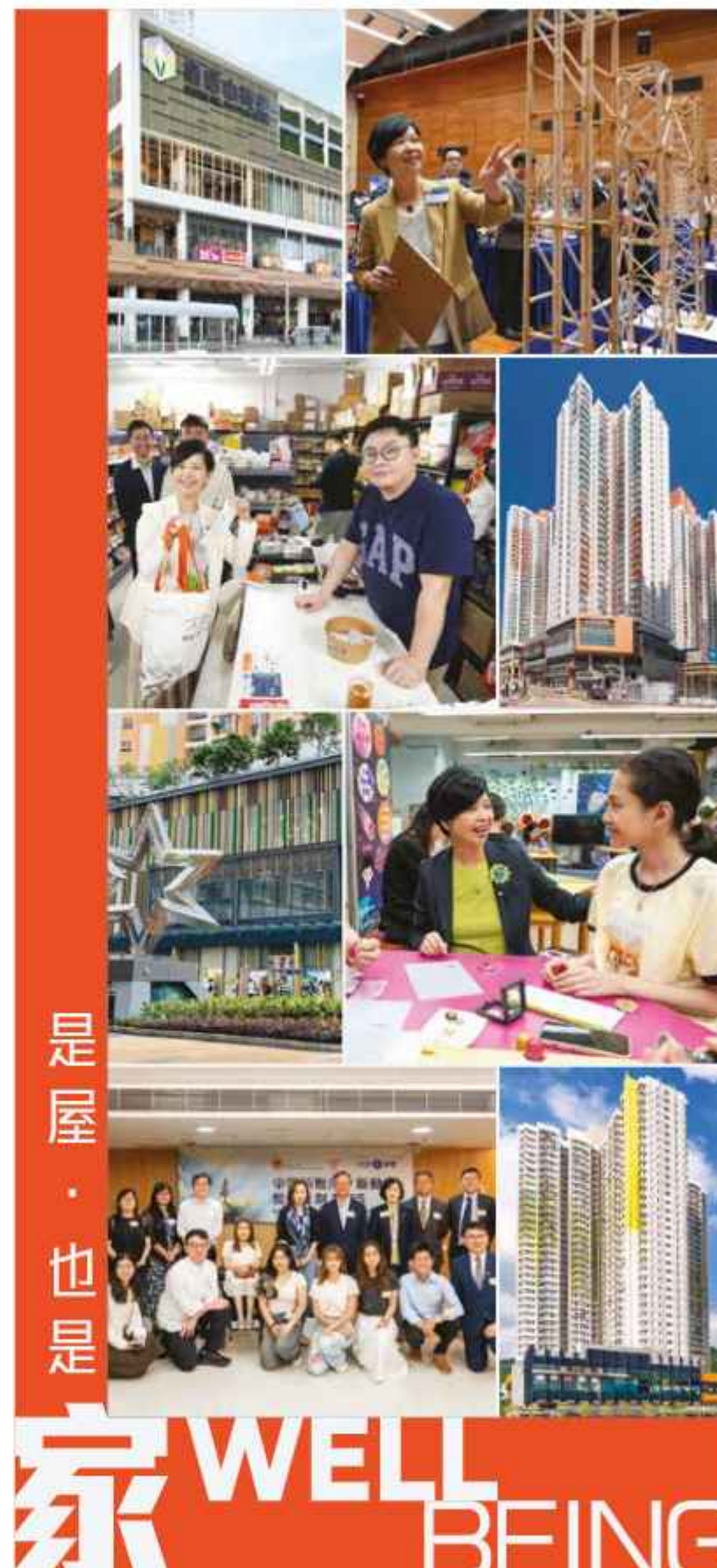

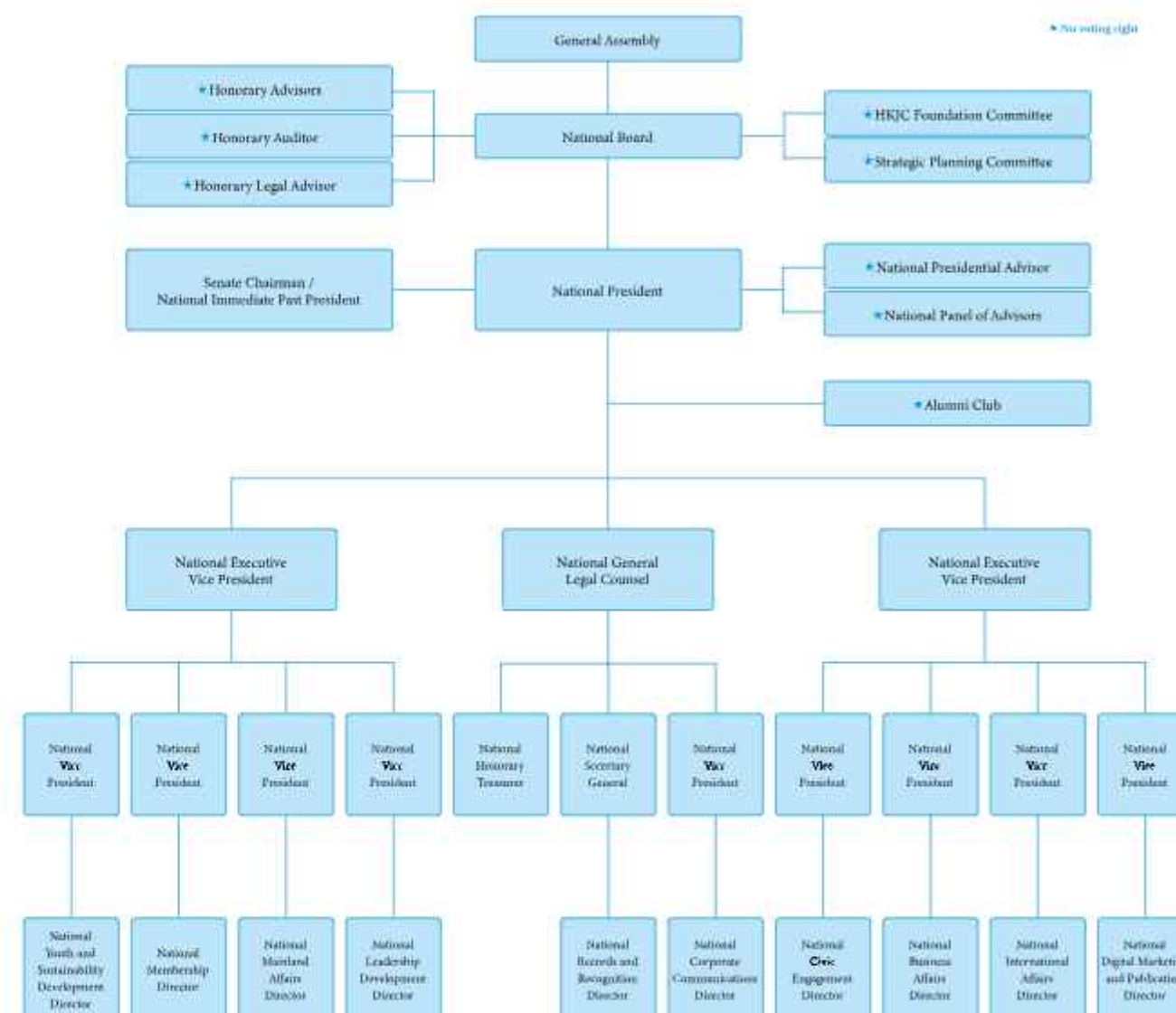

HISTORY OF JCI HONG KONG, CHINA

1950s

- 1949** The Jaycee movement was first introduced to Hong Kong by a Philippine Jaycee John Ng
- 1950** Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce was incorporated on May 6
- 1951** HKJCC hosted the 1st JCI Regional Conference
- 1956** Awarded the Best Chamber at the XI World Congress and Hon Life President Senator Arnaldo de Oliveira Sales elected as the 1st JCI President from Hong Kong



1960s

- 1962** Hosted the XVII JCI World Congress
- 1965** Kowloon Junior Chamber of Commerce was formed as the second Jaycee Chapter
- 1966**
 - With 2 local chapters, the Hong Kong body advanced to the status of a National Organization Member (NOM) of JCI.
 - The name of Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce was passed to the NOM, and the first chapter changed its name to Victoria Junior Chamber of Commerce
 - Island Junior Chamber of Commerce was formed as the third chapter
- 1967** Official publication "Harbour Lights" (1967) won the "Best NOM Publication" award at JCI World Congress Toronto, Canada
- 1969** Peninsula Junior Chamber of Commerce (4th chapter) and the first all lady chapter Hong Kong Jayceettes Junior Chamber (5th chapter) were formed

JCI Kowloon, established in 1965, is the second oldest chapter in JCI Hong Kong, dedicated to fostering personal growth and professional development. Over the years, it has organized impactful projects addressing the needs of individuals and the community.

As we approach our 60th anniversary, "Leading with Heritage," reflects our deep-rooted values and commitment to cultivating leadership through our rich history. Our 2025 theme, "Embrace the Creed, Fulfil Human Duties," promotes a culture of empathy and action, empowering young leaders to make meaningful contributions that resonate beyond their immediate surroundings.

Community Impact: Y(outh) Soul Serious 2025

"Y(outh) Soul Serious" addresses the troubling rise in youth suicide cases in Hong Kong, which increased from 23 to 32 reported cases between 2019 and 2023. This highlights the urgent need for mental health support, as many teenagers face overwhelming psychological pressure. Research shows that friendships play a vital role in mental health; young people often feel more connected to peers than to teachers or parents, according to the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups.

In response, "Youth Soul Serious" aims to build psychological resilience and promote positive thinking through activities for adolescents and children. The initiative will teach peer support and emotional adjustment techniques through a series of seminar, workshop and training camp, fostering an environment where young people can share their experiences and navigate challenges effectively, contributing to a healthier community.

Individual Development: MC in the House 2.0

"MC in the House" was designed to address the need for skilled Masters of Ceremonies (MCs) in Hong Kong's events industry. The initiative empowers young adults by providing essential communication and presentation skills for public speaking and event hosting. Participants engage in practical training, mentorship, and interactive workshops led by experienced professionals to enhance both technical and soft skills. Targeting young adults aged 18-40, the program builds confidence, offers networking opportunities, and enhances employability.

Business and Entrepreneurship: Business to the Power N

"Business to the Power N" is a flagship initiative designed to empower aspiring youth entrepreneurs in Hong Kong through targeted education and networking resources. The program offers essential training for young individuals seeking to launch their own businesses but lacking the necessary knowledge and skills. Participants gain practical insights into business fundamentals, marketing strategies, and financial management, fostering innovation and confidence in navigating the entrepreneurial landscape.

By promoting inclusive and sustainable economic growth and productive employment, "Business to the Power N" nurtures the entrepreneurial spirit among youth, helping to build resilient economies.

60th Anniversary Banquet & Sister Chapter Reception

On August 2nd, JCI Kowloon celebrated its 60th Anniversary at Kowloon Shangri-La, welcoming over 300 guests. This event highlighted the chapter's dedication to nurturing future leaders and making significant contributions both locally and internationally. The flagship initiatives enhance JCI Kowloon's branding by promoting community engagement, youth empowerment, and professional development, firmly establishing the chapter as a key organization in Hong Kong's development landscape. Five community service activities were carried out in 2025, strengthening JCI Island's role as a socially responsible organization. These projects not only benefit those in need but also create meaningful opportunities for members to serve and connect with the wider community.

Lead to the Future

Launched in September 2025, the program will equip university students with future-proof skills and real insights into artificial intelligence applications in business. Through workshops, mentoring, and networking, JCI Island aims to support young people in navigating their careers and entrepreneurial aspirations in an AI-driven economy.

On behalf of JCI Hong Kong Jayceettes, I extend our heartfelt congratulations to JCI Hong Kong, China on the successful 60th National Convention!

As we reflect on 2025, JCI Hong Kong Jayceettes celebrate a year of remarkable achievements in leadership development. We remained steadfast in our commitment to developing female leaders who can navigate an increasingly complex world. Through our theme "WE Lead the Future," we have strengthened our position as a premier organisation for young women professionals dedicated to making a difference in Hong Kong and beyond.

1. WE: Developing Leaders for a Complex World

In a landscape reshaped by AI, climate change, and geopolitical shifts, we prioritised creating an ecosystem where our members could flourish despite global uncertainties:

The SHE Sparks in Tech 2025 (她創未來 2025) programme addressed the critical gender gap in STEM fields through hands-on workshops in AI, problem-solving, and digital leadership. Partnering with industry leaders like AWS, HKSTP, and Cyberport, we provided practical, cutting-edge training for over 200 participants.

Our Future Leaders Forum: Soar to Sustainable Future (翱翔未來：永續領袖論壇) brought together close to 200 attendees from diverse sectors to explore sustainable business models. We were honoured to host speakers from leading organisations, including Cathay Pacific, MTR Corp., Regent Hotel, Tai Jai, and social enterprises and government bodies, reinforcing our commitment to responsible business leadership.

On the global stage, our UN CSW69/Beijing+30 Parallel NGO CSW Forum: "WE Lead the Future" (「巾幗創未來」聯合國第69屆婦女地位委員會非政府組織周邊論壇) positioned JCI at the forefront of global gender equality conversations. This strategic platform enabled us to amplify Hong Kong's perspectives while driving concrete advocacy for women's advancement worldwide.

2. Lead: Innovating our Operating System and Shaping the Future of Work

Recognising the need to modernise our operations and lead in the digital age, we made significant investments in digital transformation this year with two clear objectives: 1) eliminating operational friction that distracts from leadership development, and 2) creating a real-world sandbox for our members to experience the technologies shaping the future of work.

- The launch of our Next Generation Digital Platform at jcikhjayceettes.org has revolutionized the member experience by streamlining event registration and payment processing, reducing the time from two minutes to just 15 seconds.
- Our AI-powered Chapter Management has also led to significant operational efficiency gains, saving over 30 hours monthly on administrative tasks.

3. The Future: Building a High-Impact Membership

This year, we redefined what it means to be a Jayceettes by establishing ourselves as a premier leadership incubator that attracts and develops exceptional professionals through transformative experiences. We welcomed a number of high-caliber recruits – individuals who demonstrate both professional and leadership potential.

Our international exposure reached record levels as we led the largest delegation to the Mongolia ASPAC and hosted the Asia-Pacific Lady LOMS Convention (APLLC), where we opened doors to participants beyond the APLC alliance for the first time, and engaged over 300 participants to discuss AI adoption across the region.

We are proud to have empowered our members to establish thought leadership through over 15 speaking and judging engagements locally and globally. Our Chapter received special accreditation from the United Nations to participate in two significant meetings in September focusing on youth and women's development.

The project culminated in a press conference cum carnival at Tsuen King Circuit Sports Centre, which was attended by more than 2,500 families.

JCI Tsuen Wan demonstrate a key partner to the Tsuen Wan District, working collaboratively on projects that directly benefit the local community. This strong relationship allows us to empower young leaders and create a positive impact, ensuring our efforts are aligned with the district's vision for a thriving and vibrant Tsuen Wan.

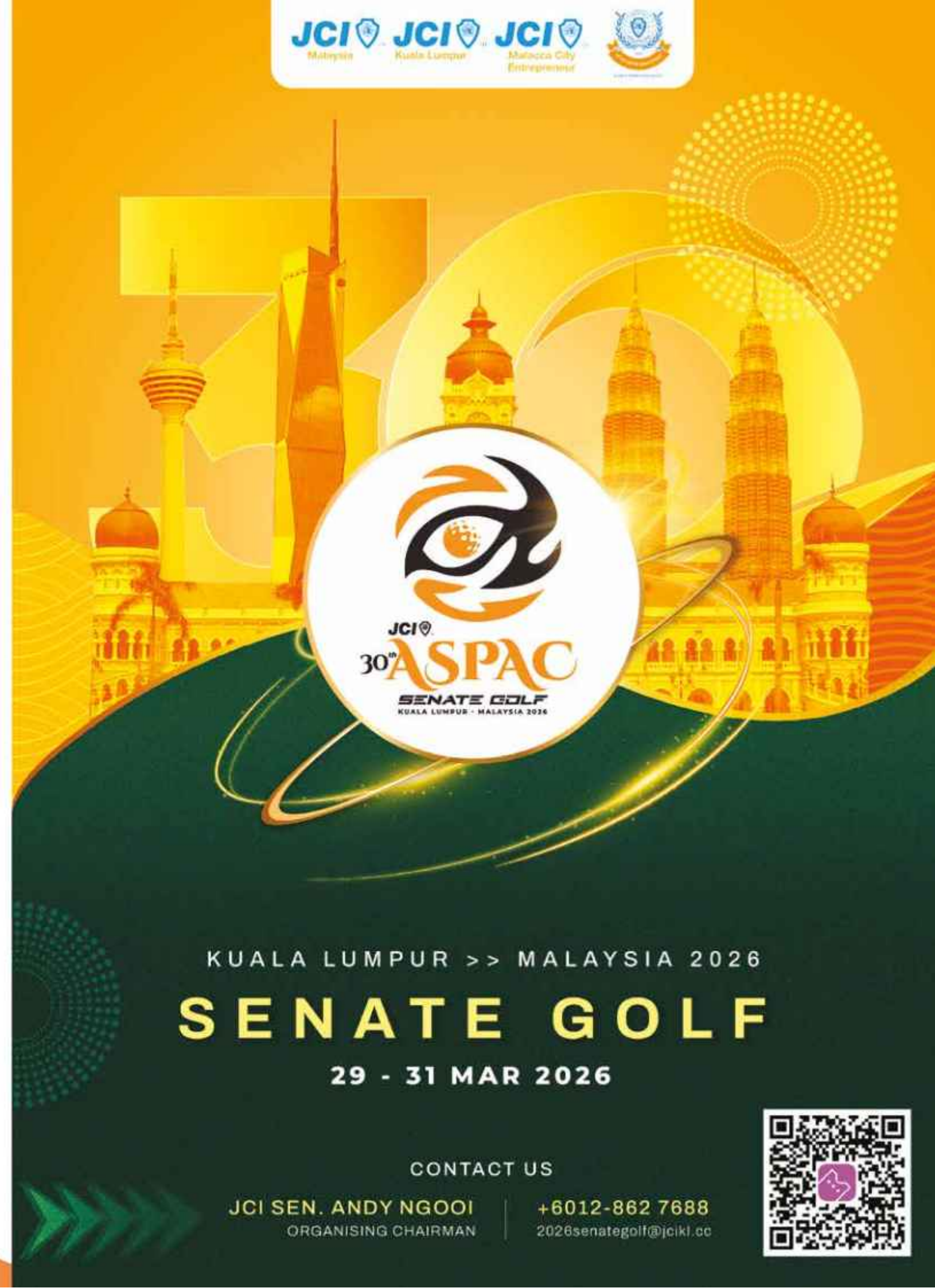


JCI Lantau, established in 2016, is a progressive, mixed-gender, and English-speaking chapter that has consistently championed sustainability and community development.

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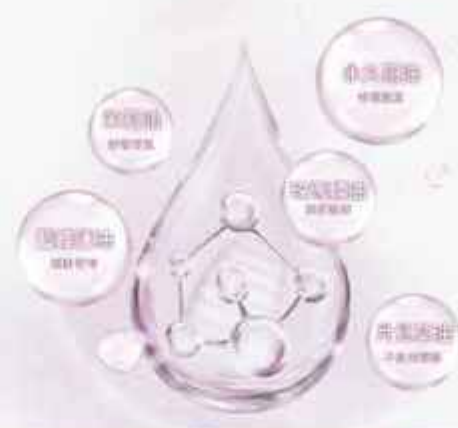
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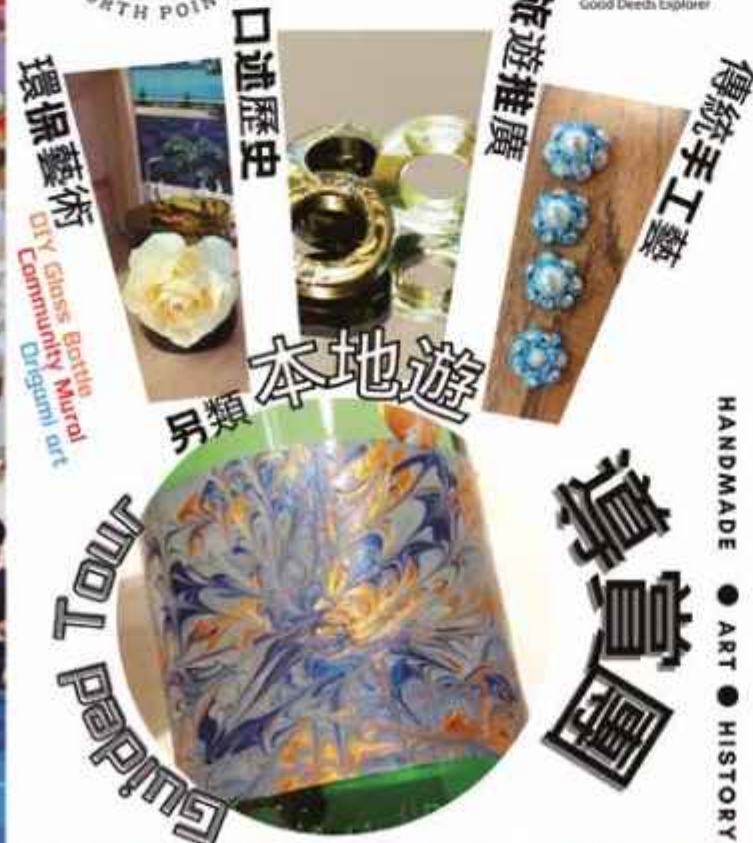
