Open Forum and Development forum

The day started with an Open Forum, offering JCI members a meaningful platform to engage with the National Board. Throughout the session, the board addressed over seven member inquiries, spanning topics such as administration, international affairs, records and recognition, and communications. The Development Forum welcomed a distinguished panel of different National Presidents (NP) who shared their insights on branding development. 2010 NP Senators Gene Tang, 2012 NP Stanley Ng, 2014 NP Johnny Kwan, 2015 NP Anthony Leung, and 2020 NP Maric Cheng drew from their leadership experiences to explore strategies for building a strong and lasting brand. Their perspectives sparked meaningful dialogue and offered valuable takeaways for members looking to elevate JCI's identity and impact.
