
the books on 2023, I am happy to report that our 22nd Infantry Regiment Society is 643 strong. We have completed the transition of the majority

Ervin A. French, Jr.

A 2nd Battalion 22nd Infantry soldier killed in the hedgerow fighting in Normandy during World War Two.

Ervin Alexander French Jr. was born in Bay City, Matagorda County, Texas on



April 9, 1925, one of three sons born to **Ervin** and Lessie French. Prior to entering military service he was employed by the National Biscuit Company (NABISCO).

French was drafted into the Army on July 28, 1943 at Houston, Texas. At the time of induction he was single and had completed grammar school. He stood five feet nine inches tall and weighed 140 pounds. He indicated his religion as Protestant. He took his initial training at the U.S. Army Infantry Replacement Training Center at Camp Fannin, Texas. French sailed overseas to England in April 1944 and was put in the 4th Infantry Division replacement pool. On June 13, 1944, he was one of 63 enlisted men assigned that day as replacements, to Company G 2nd Battalion 22nd Infantry 4th Infantry Division. In the week since D-Day, the Regiment had suffered a large number of casualties, and a considerable amount of replacements were sent to the 22nd Infantry, in order to keep it at fighting strength.

French took part in 2nd Battalion's attack against the Quineville Ridge, and the assault against the Maupertus airfield, in the battle for Cherbourg. After the fall of Cherbourg he and his Battalion moved south and began the advance through Normandy.

On July 7, 1944 orders were given to the 22nd Infantry that their next major objective would be the town of Periers, to the southwest of Carentan. On July 8 French's 2nd Battalion led the attack, in an attempt to breach the German lines just below the village of Culot. The planned objective for the day was to take and occupy the town of La Maugerie, about 10 kilometers southwest of Carentan, just 2 kilometers southwest of Sainteny.

Though enemy resistance was strong, 2nd Battalion advanced to within 500 yards of the village of Culot, about a mile and a half away from their objective of La Maugerie. German Mark V Panther tanks, accompanied by Infantry, charged into the American assault in a counterattack, and halted any further progress by 2nd Battalion. A 57mm gun from the 22nd Infantry's Anti-Tank Company knocked out one enemy tank. French's fellow soldier from Company G, Private Eugene Hix, knocked out another with a bazooka.

The German counterattack had been stopped, but French was badly wounded during the fight. Fragments from enemy artillery or tank cannon fire tore through French's thigh and leg, and took him out of the battle. He was removed to a forward medical facility, where his wounds proved to be too severe, and he died the next day, on July 9, 1944. He was 19 years old.

Ervin A. French Jr. was buried in the temporary American cemetery, St. Mere Eglise #1 near Carentan. In 1948 his remains were returned to the United States, where he was laid to his final rest in South Park Cemetery, Pearland, Brazoria County, Texas.






teams for their welcome. We took this opportunity to introduce the Association and our sponsor Curtis, and also to set up our recruitment stand.


SSG Michael Ollis Freedom Foundation
