Called to Worshiping

Worshiping: The feeling or expression of reverence and adoration for a deity.

In January, I introduced the Key of Praying in Tongues. In February, I introduced the Key of Confessing the Word. In March, I introduced the Key of Fasting, in April, I introduced the Key of Meditating the Word, and this wonderful month of May, I will introduce the Key of Worshiping. I want us to believe and understand we have a role to play in our relationship with God, the Father. We must emerge ourselves in these 5 Keys to make us desperate enough to do anything it takes to get closer and closer to Him.

These last five months I have used the term introducing. That means exactly that. These small monthly exaltations are not intended to be exhaustive teachings on the Five Keys, but they are meant to be a small sampler, if you will, on the Keys we hold dear to get closer and closer to the Father.

Worshiping in your inner sanctuary means that you start praising and loving on Jesus as if He were right there in the room or closet with you. Worshiping is not the time to ask for anything specifically or even confess anything but your love toward Him.

In the times when we worship, there are those moments that one can actually feel the presence of the Lord. I know, I know, we are not to go by feelings, however there is a presence your knower knows about. There are some who say we don't need music to worship and I whole-heartedly agree, but having music in the background, not overbearing, and preferably instrumental, aids me in keeping my emotions in check. I know love is an emotion and expressing love gets quite personal, but what I meant by keeping the emotions in check is that I don't want

to start worshiping the song or music, as I have in the past, I want to worship the Lord Jesus Christ and all His glory.

Worshiping in your inner sanctuary works best for me when I start out telling Him how much I love Him. I make sure I thank the Father for providing Salvation through Jesus, Healing through Jesus, Provision through Jesus, Peace through Jesus, Wisdom through Jesus, and Truth through Jesus. Then I start just loving on Him. I tell Him how much I love Him—through my heart, soul, mind, and body. I tell Him He is the only One I worship—I have no other gods before Him, I acknowledge to Him that He bought me with His own sacrifice. Just keep telling Him what He means to you.

Worshiping in your inner sanctuary does a few things for you, personally. That kind of deep worship brings peace to your soul and mind. That kind of deep worship brings healing. I can remember one time while I was at the old church building on 5th and Coronado, early one morning, I was well in an hour of just worshiping Jesus, when the telephone rang. I was hesitant at first to answer it, but I did and on the other end of the line was a lady who needed prayer for an ailment in her body. I hadn't realized it at the time, but I had been feeling the presence of the Lord during worship—an electricity in the air. I started praying for her and then there was silence for a time and she told me thanks, her pain had left her. My only conclusion was that, electricity I felt in the air, was none other than the healing power of Jesus going through the phone!

I dare you—no, I double dog dare you—next time you are worshiping and you have something you want out of your body or that of a loved one, just start lifting that up to Him. I promise you, healing goes hand in hand with worship.

The Father love to hear His children tell Him how much they love Him. I get all “goosebumpy” when Bev tells me she loves me, I get goosebumps on goosebumps when my children tell me they love me. And, I get a triple dose of

goosebumps when my grandchildren tell me they love me. If you would take thirty minutes to an hour to worship God, telling Him how much you love Him, I guarantee, He will bestow blessings on you without measure. (NOTE: YOU DON'T HAVE TO WORSHIP HIM TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR BLESSINGS) Blessings will come to those who seek The Father, His kingdom, and righteousness. Seek and you will find.

Now, about those emotions—they will come—I have cried for 10-15 minutes in His presence. I feel so good during those times. It's like He is cleansing me and making my slate clean as if I had just been born again.

If anything is hindering you or coming between the Father and you, then you must ask God to prune it out. Know that He will—Praise Jesus!

These Five Keys—Praying in tongues, Meditating the Word, Fasting, Confessing the Word, and Worshiping in your inner sanctuary do different things to get you closer to The Father. Know that is what He wants from you—a closeness—intimate relationship—knowing you would do anything He asks you to do, go anywhere He asks you to go.

We are definitely in the last times. Don't waste it—don't blow it.
