

#### **Compliance Checklist (for International Buyers)**

This checklist is designed to minimize risks in **donor-funded projects** and **high-compliance procurements** by ensuring documentation integrity, supplier transparency, and contractual security.

#### 1. Documentation

- Mill Test Certificate (MTC) with traceable heat number for each lot
- Packing List & Weight Note detailed by origin, tonnage, and size
- Certificate of Origin Chamber of Commerce certified
- Bill of Lading / CMR full logistics traceability
- **Pre-Shipment Inspection Report** (optional, strongly recommended for donor-funded projects)

# 2. Supplier Verification

- Company Registration Documents (Commercial Registry, Tax ID, etc.)
- KYC / AML Screening against international sanctions and watch lists
- **Origin Compliance** no sourcing risks from sanctioned regions (US/EU sanctions)

# 3. Contract & Payment

- Formula Pricing Annex Platts / LME indexed pricing
- Clear Incoterms (FOB, CFR, CIF)
- Payment Method Irrevocable LC / Escrow for secure settlement
- Optional Volume Clauses for demand fluctuations and flexibility

## 4. Logistics & Delivery

- Milestone Delivery Plan phased shipment schedule
- **Buffer Stock / Advance Depot** to mitigate border crossing uncertainties
- Insurance Policy All Risk (Institute Cargo Clauses A) coverage

## 5. Compliance & Risk Notes

- Sanctions Compliance Caesar Act / EU–US secondary sanctions (for Syria projects)
- **Donor Requirements** World Bank / UN procurement standards, additional certifications if required
- Carbon/Green Compliance low-carbon certificates (if applicable)
