Leslie- 8 pointed star

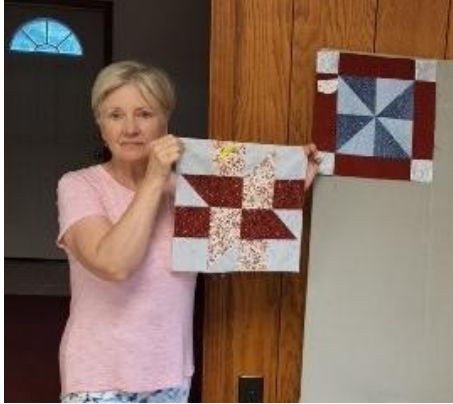


Sandy - a quilt for a young child. (She will get a pattern for us.)
