BJ made a motion to approve the minutes and Treasurer's report as presented in the newsletter. The Guild members agreed.

Linda had donated a bunch of quilts to Crossnore. We will have at least 10 for this purpose and possibly get a photo for the website.

Noel has donated some kits for Crossnore quilts, and we have more fabric in the very organized closet. Both Cindy and Tiffany have donated to the closet collection, and we thank them. Please help yourself to this fabric for any quilts for Crossnore which you are inspired to make.

We are working on the Winter Solstice quilt by Cory Quilts for our future Raffle Quilt. We have some blocks made and Jo Marie is cutting some of the fabric with her AccuQuilt GO Cutter. We are hoping it will be finished before the Wooly Worm Festival.

Tiffany has been in contact with several companies who have sent donations to the guild.
