

JUDY'S STAR

12" Square

Four colors needed

Fabric:

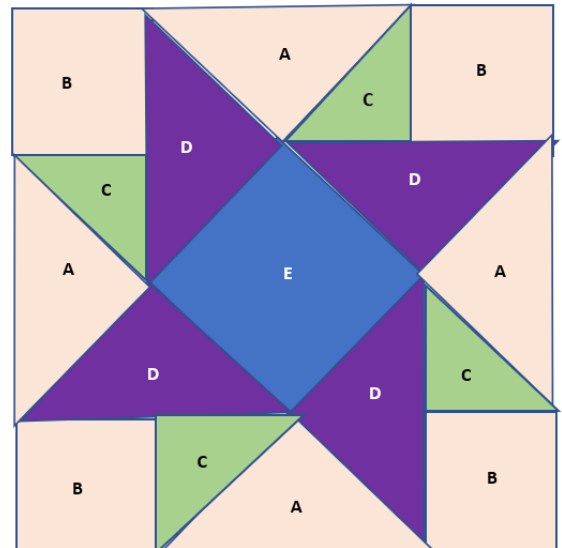
A (Light) – Cut 1 square – $7\frac{1}{4}$ " – cut in half diagonally twice to form 4 triangles

B (Light) – Cut 4 squares – $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

C (Medium) – Cut 2 squares – $3\frac{7}{8}$ " – cut in half diagonally once to form 4 triangles

D (Dark) - Cut 1 square – $7\frac{1}{4}$ " – cut in half diagonally twice to form 4 triangles

E (Med or Dark print) – Cut 1 square – $4\frac{3}{4}$ "



Technique: When sewing a diagonal setting, you will sew the center unit together first, then the two corner units.

1. Chain piece the 4 B units to C units. Press seams under B. Set 2 B/C units aside
2. To 2 B/C units, add a D piece along the long side. Press seams under B/C units
3. Sew the 2 B/C/D units to opposite sides of E. Press seams under E center unit. Set aside
4. Sew 2 A units to the 2 remaining D units. Pay close attention to placement. Press seams under A
5. Sew the 2 remaining B/C units to the 2 A/D units you just made, along the long D side. Press seams under B/C
6. Add an A unit to the opposite side of each A/D/B/C unit along the C side. Press seams under C
7. Join one corner unit to opposite sides of the center unit. Press seams under corner units
8. Press and square to $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
