

Technique 1

# **KINGS CROWN**

12" Square

Three colors needed



### Fabric:

A (Light) - Cut 4 squares - 3 1/2 "

B (Dark) – Cut 4 squares – 3 7/8" – cut in half diagonally once to form 8 triangles

C (Medium) – cut 1 square – 7 ¼ "– cut in half diagonally twice to form 4 triangles

D (Dark) - Cut 1 square - 6 1/2 "

## Technique:


Sew the B units to C. Repeat 3 times

Add A units to each end of 2 B/C units. Press seams under A units

Sew two remaining B/C units to two opposite sides of D. Press seams under D

Add the A/B/C units to the top and bottom of B/C/D unit

Press and square to 12 1/2





## Technique 2

# **KINGS CROWN**

12" Square

Three colors needed



#### Fabric:

A (Light) - Cut 4 squares - 3 1/2 "

B (Dark) - Cut 8 squares - 3 ½ "

C (Medium) - cut 4 rectangles - 6 1/2" x 3 1/2 "

D (Dark) - Cut 1 square - 6 1/2 "

### Technique:

Draw a diagonal line through all your B units on the wrong side

Lay a B unit right sides together with C unit, with the diagonal line running as shown here. Sew right on that diagonal line. Trim off the excess, leaving a ¼ inch seam allowance. Press to the C unit



Repeat this same step again with another background square on the other side of this same unit. Press to the C unit. Repeat 3 times. Make sure your rectangles still measure 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  by 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ .





Add A units to each end of 2 B/C units. Press seams under A units

Sew two remaining B/C units to two opposite sides of D. Press seams under D

Add the A/B/C units to the top and bottom of B/C/D unit

Press and square to 12 1/2 "
