

## .22 Rimfire 50 Yard Bench Rest

### Course of Fire:

Target is the IBS Rimfire – 50 yard target. There are 4 – sighter bulls and 25 - bulls for score.

Best edge scoring used. Note: this is one of the easier 50 yd rimfire targets; great for beginners!

X dot..... .070 inch dot

9 ring..... .770 inch

10 ring..... .500 inch

8 ring..... 1.00 inch

Note: if more than one shot appears in a score bull, the lowest score will be counted.

### Relay A: 25 minute time limit

- Sighting rounds as desired.
- Twenty five rounds for score.

### Relay B: 20 minute time limit

- \* Sighting rounds as desired
- \* Twenty five rounds for score

If number of shooters allows: (if 20 or less shooters)

### Relay C: 20 minute time limit

- Sighting rounds as desired.
- Twenty five rounds for score.

### Equipment and Firearms

Please bring appropriate eye and hearing protection and empty chamber indicators.

### All Classes

- Any .22 rimfire rifle (Short, Long, and/or Long Rifle only).
- Sandbag or Bi-pod front rest. Sandbag rear rest.
- Front & rear rest must not be joined or attached to the bench (no 1-piece rests).
- No devices to retard recoil or return to battery allowed (no bungee cords).
- No limit on scope magnification. Wind flags/indicators allowed.

### Sporter Class

- **8 ½ pounds maximum** including bi-pod (if used) and sights/optics.
- Factory "as issued" gun with the original stock, barrel, and trigger.
- No tuners or fluted barrels. No stock fore-end adapter plates.
- Factory stock; bedding allowed, barrels may be free-floated.
- Factory barrel (new crowning allowed with ½ inch maximum barrel removal). Must retain all visible factory markings.
- Factory trigger (may be reworked/modified but not replaced by an aftermarket trigger).

### Custom Class

- **10 ½ pounds maximum** including bi-pod (if used) and sights/optics.
- Any stock, barrel, or trigger.
- No barrel tuners.

### Unlimited Class

- **No maximum weight**
- Any stock, barrel, or trigger.
- Tuners are allowed.

\* Iron-sighted guns may be shot in any of the above 3 classes provided weight limits are met.
