Happy September!

I feel like this year especially, September has really snuck up on me. I mean I have been celebrating the start of school and having a quiet house again while the boys are at school but still it does not seem like we should be here already. The busyness of fall has started and with the boys all playing football this year, it seems we are always on the run. I know that we are not alone in this adventure of life but man, can it be exhausting trying to coordinate schedules, hoping you get it all on the calendar and hoping you didn't forget anything but knowing inevitably you did.

In the church, September is also busy. We are starting choir and bell practice back up in the first week of September as well as Sunday School.
