PASTOR'S PEN



Happy June!

This month marks the end of my fourth year here at Elmwood and Murdock and what a crazy four years it has been. Our kids have all started school in the Elmwood-Murdock School system. Nick went from having to commute to Omaha to working exclusively from home. The importance of online worship became so abundantly clear. We have had times where we have been afraid to leave our homes for fear of sickness and times where we could not wait to leave our house just so we could see another person. Many friendships have been built and partnerships have been made.

I never would have been able to imagine where life would take us when we accepted the call to come serve these two communities four years ago. We were apprehensive and excited to start anew in these communities. It is hard to come in as an outsider, especially to a small community where everyone knows everyone and most of them are related to each other.

And yet we came, we moved in, got our kids into school and day care and began a new adventure. Being here has been a true blessing. It is one that I brag about a lot when talking to my clergy friends because I believe it is one of the best appointments out there. This little hidden gem of two communities, that care for each other and I believe really want what is best for each other and the world.

The church has gone through some serious transitions. Elmwood and Murdock had never shared a pastor before; and although it made sense to do so, it had never been done before. Murdock was recording their services before we got here but to put them online and then to stream them online was all new, and Elmwood had never done either. In the Spring of 2020, of course that became a necessity as we were unable to worship in person because of COVID-19. The advances in technology, although necessary, have definitely changed how we do worship. People don't have to be in the pews anymore to be "present." This means that we have to keep working on ways to engage people outside of worship. It means that we can't just hope that we will see people on Sunday and check in with them then. We have to make an effort to reach out at different times. Jesus didn't wait for the people to come to him; he traveled and found the people where they were. We need to be more diligent about meeting the people where they are and not just hoping that they will show up on a Sunday morning.

June is Annual Conference time. The meeting of the Great Plains Conference where the business of the church is discussed, as well as the budget and where we are going from here. It is a time of our marching orders and a time where new appointments are set for the next year. I enjoy the Annual Conference because I get to see my clergy friends and I get to announce to you all that I will be here for another year! I am so excited to see what year five has in store for us and I pray for many more going forward.

Let us focus on the joy from God and the ways that it can lead us forward. The book of James says this: "Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing." Through whatever trials come our way, may we use the joy and knowledge of God's presence to carry us through.
