

## PASTOR'S PEN



#### Greetings!

We have made it to March and the beginning of Lent. We often treat Lent as a time where we must deprive ourselves of something. As I was growing up, I remember giving up things like candy, chocolate, gum or soda. It was a time where I could not wait to get to Easter so I could gorge myself on whatever it was that I had given up. My friends would also give something up but would count the days and realize that Sundays don't count towards the 40 days of Lent so they would partake in giving something up except for on Sundays, where they were allowed to eat or do whatever it was that they had given up. As I reflect on those times now, I am not sure that it was really what the theologians had in mind when this tradition of depravity was created.

I want to encourage you to approach this Lent maybe differently than you have in the past. Instead of giving up something that you have no intention of giving up for longer than 40 days, what if we used these 40 days to discern, to pray to explore more deeply where we feel that God is calling us as individuals and as a church. We take these 40 days and see where we can make the most impact in our community, in our families and ourselves. It is important to find a space every day to spend in prayer, to have the conversation with God.

The kids learned the 5-finger prayer in February; it is a great base, a place to get started when praying. When looking at your hand, each finger represents a category that is important in prayer. To thank God, to tell God we love him, to say we are sorry for our sins, to ask God to help others, to ask God to help us and then in the end to remember that we are listening for God's responses. We use that as a base and then fill in the gaps to fit the situation we are in. When we really take the time to be in prayer and to listen, we will find ourselves led to do amazing things, to take leaps of faith and know that God will continue to provide.

Psalm 121:1-3 says "I raise my eyes toward the mountains. Where will my help come from? <sup>2</sup>My help comes from the LORD, the maker of heaven and earth. <sup>3</sup>God won't let your foot slip. Your protector won't fall asleep on the job." When we discern and travel the path that God has set out for us God protects us, he provides and he helps us along the way.

I pray that in this time of Lent that you are all able to take the time to pray, discern and are felt led by God to continue to do His work.
