Sir Winston Churchill Band Program Costs 2019-2020

Without the support of the parents, the music program would not be able to achieve all of the goals set out for the year. Our music program cannot exist without YOUR support. While costs continue to rise, educational budgets are being frozen or reduced, and everyone is required to keep expenses to a minimum. Although we are frugal in our spending, the welfare of the program is at the mercy of the economic climate; our financial salvation has been our active parent organization. While the generation of extra funds is an important function of the band parents, it is not the organization's sole purpose nor should it be seen as the reason for the group's existence. There is a much greater agenda at hand – the opportunity to create a partnership with your daughter / son and actively participate in an exciting mutual journey of success... making a dream come true. Band is a family affair.

SWCBPA Yearly Program Enrichment Fund \$275

The **SWCBPA** supports program expenses that go beyond the regular scope of school fees and helps cover enrichment opportunities. This program support is not mandatory for participation in band, but is crucial for Band activities such as - Clinicians, Guest Conductors, Music Festival Registration & Travel, Performances at the Rozsa Center, Uniforms, Awards, and Extra Listening Opportunities.

The Enrichment Fund also allows the SWCBPA to present an honorarium to our Key Volunteer who provides countless hours of assistance in the band office. The Key Volunteer helps with the organization of forms, music library, fundraising and day-to-day operations of the SWCBPA.

We ask that payment for the Program Enrichment Fund be made by October 1st, 2019. Alternate payment plans may be arranged through the key volunteer.

Fundraising – New This Year!

Fundraisers occur several times throughout the year and will be sent home with the students in the band. Though fundraising is voluntary, it is also strongly encouraged that everybody does their share. Student proceeds from fundraising are tracked as travel credit and will directly go to off-set the cost of that student's trip costs. The purpose of fundraising is to help fund activities (like the band program) while taking less money from the band member's direct family. Ask extended family or friends, not just mom and dad. Students should be the main fundraising member of the family, not their parents. Encourage your child to make the phone call to their grandparents, or show the fundraiser to their friend's parents. Unused travel credits will be rolled over to the following year or transferred to a direct family member.
