Copper (cp)	1	1/10	1/50	1/100	1/999

Platinum (pp)	1,000	100	20	10	1

One gold piece is worth ten silver pieces, the most prevalent coin among commoners. A silver piece buys a laborer's work for half a day, a flask of lamp oil, or a night's rest in a poor inn.

One silver piece is worth the copper pieces, which are common among laborers and beggars. A single copper piece buys a candle, a torch, or a piece of chalk.

The electrum piece (ep) and the platinum piece (pp) originate from fallen empires and lost kingdoms, and they sometimes arouse suspicion and skepticism when used in transactions.
