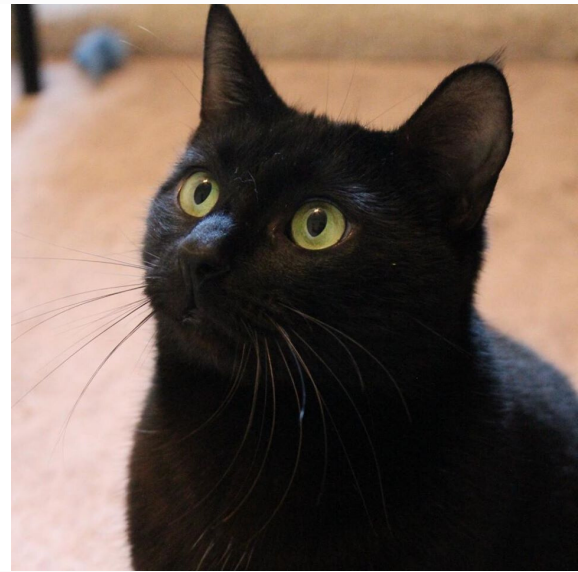

FOSTER TO ADOPT OPTION DUE TO COVID-19

HOW YOU CAN STILL ADD A FAITHFUL
FRIEND TO YOUR FAMILY!

Effective immediately until further notice, Faithful Friends Pet Rescue and Rehoming will be temporarily altering our 'foster to adopt' policies.

As a part of the community response to Covid-19, many veterinarians and non-profit veterinary organizations have cancelled elective procedures such as spay and neuter surgeries due to lack of staff availability and need to conserve PPE for the human healthcare field. In order to remove barriers to timely and successful placement of animals in our care, FFPRR will place cats and dogs who have not been spayed or neutered into 'foster to adopt' homes, with the understanding that these services will be performed as soon as these services are offered again.

LONG TERMER MAMA LOU NEEDS A FOREVER HOME!

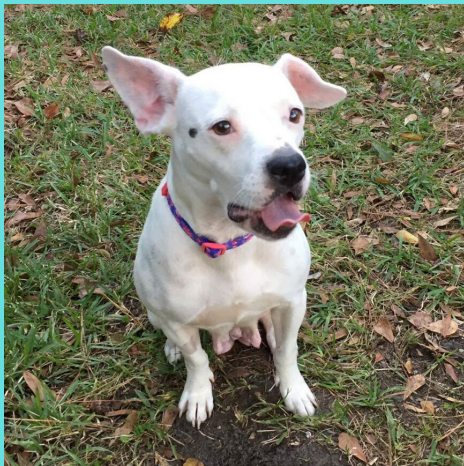
HELP US HELP HER FIND A FOREVER HOME!

HOW WE CONTINUE TO SAVE LIVES
DURING COVID-19

To say that these are trying times would be an understatement, but despite the major changes to every day life as we know it, Faithful Friends continues to provide life saving options to animals in our community.

We have cancelled our major Saturday Petsmart adoption events for the unforeseeable future, but continue to do individual meet and greets and adoptions with the help of our amazing volunteer adoption counselors.

Our adoption process is now completely digital! The first step is to submit an adoption application via our website. Within 48-72 hours, you'll receive an email back answering any questions you may have and to set up a time to meet and hopefully adopt your new friend! Adoptions and meetings are still taking place at the Archer Road Petsmart but we are meeting outside in order to follow proper social distancing protocols.

We are currently only accepting credit and debit card payments for adoption fees in order to keep our adoption counselors safe! Every adoption will allow us to continue to pull animals from local shelters, which are currently experiencing their own struggles due to COVID-19.

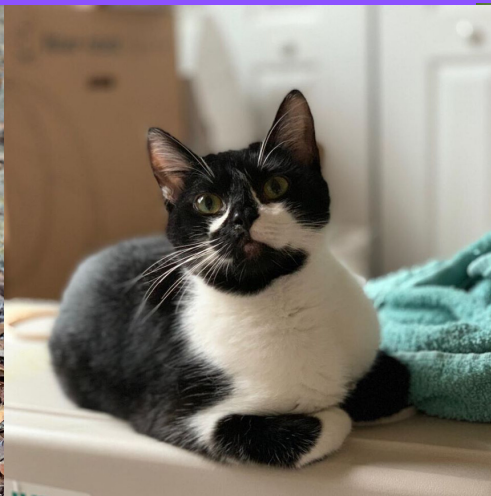

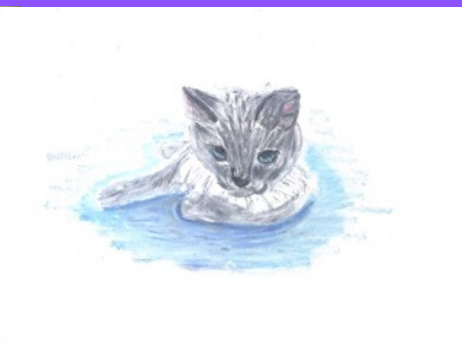
We'd also like to send out a thank you to her patient husband Matt, for being forgiving when she brings home yet another foster as well as helping with medical treatments and transport tasks.
