MOSS STITCH KNIT HAT WITH CROCHET EDGE

Needles:

size 8 circular 16" size 7 double pointed Crochet hook size: ?

Light worsted wool

Color 1 (Wool Ease in oatmeal 1 skein)
Color 2 (Wool Ease in Moss - 1/4 skein) approx.

Cast on 85 stitches (adult hat) on circular needle, place marker at beginning and join to create a circle.

Knit one round.

Begin pattern:

Row 1: k1, p1, k1 repeat to marker

Row 2: p1, k1, p1 repeat to marker

Row 3: p1, k1, p1 repeat to marker

Row 4: k1, p1, k1 repeat to marker.

Repeat all 4 rows until work is about 6 - 7 inches (approx X rows)

Transition Row: Purl entire row to marker.

Row X - XX: Knit 3 rows around to marker

Decrease

Row: Knit 17, k2tog* repeat to end

Knit next row

Row: Knit 15, k2tog* repeat to end

Row: Knit 13 k2tog* repeat to end

Switch to size 7 double point needles

Change color to moss by joining with small knot or wet join

Row: Knit 7, k2tog* repeat to end

Rows X - XX: Knit 5, k2tog* until you have X stitches on the needles.

Using a tapestry needle, pull thread through stitches to make crown of hat and tie off inside hat (WS) and weave in ends.

Crochet edge:

Using color 2 single crochet around brim edge by putting needle through WS in the knit row. Join to end and begin edging.

Simple crochet edging

Chain 3, single crochet in every other single crochet stitch repeat across brim and tie off when back to beginning.
