UNVEILING, CONTINUED

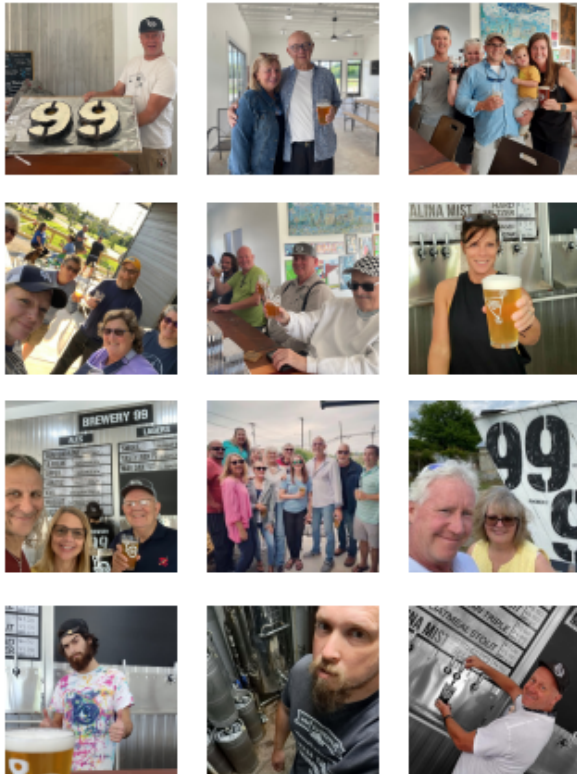
