



HAVE A CUP A TEA ON ME! TEA BAG HOLDER OR CANDY BAG



Start with a 3 1/2" X 7" rectangle of decorative fabric. You can make this any size for candy, tea bag or even lipstick.

Fold in half so you have a 3 1/2" X 3 1/2" square



- Cut the top with pinking shears. Round the edge or make a V by folding sides together.



- Place bag at the front of presser foot with folded edge toward the foot. Serge the side and continue serger a tail.



Set your serger to a 3 or 2 thread rolled hem – according to the manual.

- Begin serging a string. Allow thread to curl at back of machine. Serge about 3" of thread. Don't pull thread tail.



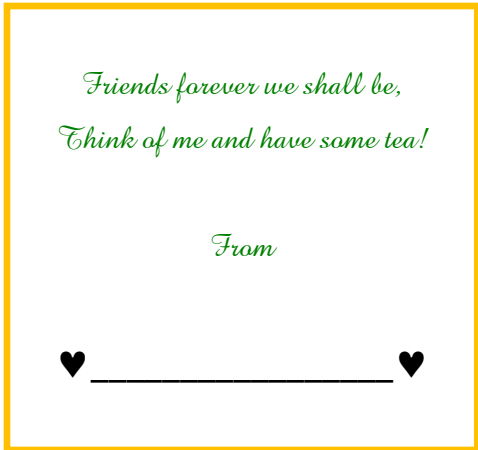
- Keep serging until thread string is about 8" long.



- Place the other side of the bag under the presser foot going from the top down.



- Continue serging until you have a thread tail the same length at the one on the other side. Leave them hanging at the bottom.
