

Cover everything from personal calendars to notebooks

Measurements are for Mead monthly or weekly planners. (4" X 6 1/2") Instructions can be adapted for any type of book cover. Supplies:

- 2 coordinating fat quarters
 - I will refer to the main fabric that shows as the fashion fabric the inside fabric I will refer to as lining. A small portion of the lining fabric will peek out behind the pocket on the inside.
- ½ yd of heavy fusible interfacing (craft bond works well)
- Thread to match fabric

Fusible interfacing:

- For a Mead calendar the measurements are 6 3/4" X 8"
- Cut 2 of fusible interfacing.

OR take your own measurements

- height ↑ ______"
 Close book and measure width ↔ around fold. _____





interfacing to the exact measurement of cover.

Fold interfacing width in half and mark center of interfacing.

Cutting fashion fabric and lining:

For a Mead calendar one 7 ³/₄" X 15" of fashion fabric and one of lining fabric. If using your own measurements, add 1" to height \updownarrow _____" and 7" to width \leftrightarrow _____".

**NOTE - extra 7" is for a 3 ½" pocket on inside of both sides.

Hem pockets:

- Working with the outside edge of the width of fashion fabric, fold wrong side under 5/8" and press.
- Top stitch folded edge. Do this on both ends of fashion fabric.
- Fold in half and mark center at top and bottom.





- Working with lining fabric, turn under 1/2" on out side edges and press
- Top stitch folded edge. Do this on both ends of lining fabric.
- Fold in half and make center at top and bottom.

Interfacing to fabric:

• Matching the center lines, place fusible interfacing ½" from top edge matching center lines. Interface both fashion fabric and lining pieces in same way.




Forming pockets:

 Working with fashion fabric, turn edge of pocket toward center with right sides together. Press well. Do this with both lining and fashion fabric.



Putting fabric together:

• Place fashion fabric on lining with right sides together. Match up interfacing edges. Pin to secure. NOTICE: Pocket wrong sides are on the inside sandwiched in the middle.



Stitch along top at raw edge of fabric following interfacing line.



• Trim away seam allowance to 1/8".

Turning:

Turn right side out (pockets will be wrong side out on each side). Press.



Turn fashion fabric pocket toward lining pocket. Press.



Edge stitching:

Using an edge stitching foot on your machine, adjust sewing machine needle position so you are stitching close to edge. Topstitch starting at center and going all the ways ground outside. ing all the way around outside edge.



Insert calendar.



Notice you also have an extra pocket on both sides.
