Cross Talk free motion design:

I love to do free motion. You can get such a great impression if you use the right products. I am now carrying In-R-Form by Bosal. This is a great product for adding body to purses and also great for free motion or machine embroidery with straight stitch designs. One side is fusible to keep your fabric in place.

The pattern is the Cross Talk cell holder from [www.alldunndesigns.com](http://www.alldunndesigns.com)



To apply design:

- Cut fabric and backing larger than pattern. Once you finish the design you will trim to normal cutting line.
- Fuse backing to wrong side of fabric.
- Trace design on wrong side of front and pocket. Also trace pattern outline for cutting later. (bobbin thread will be showing on the top side)



- Be sure and lower feed-dogs and bring your presser foot lever down. Take 1 stitch and bring bottom thread to top of fabric.
- Hold thread for a few stitching and then cut off. Begin following drawn lines.
- You can stitch just the outline or if you wish you can stipple all the open area around the design.
