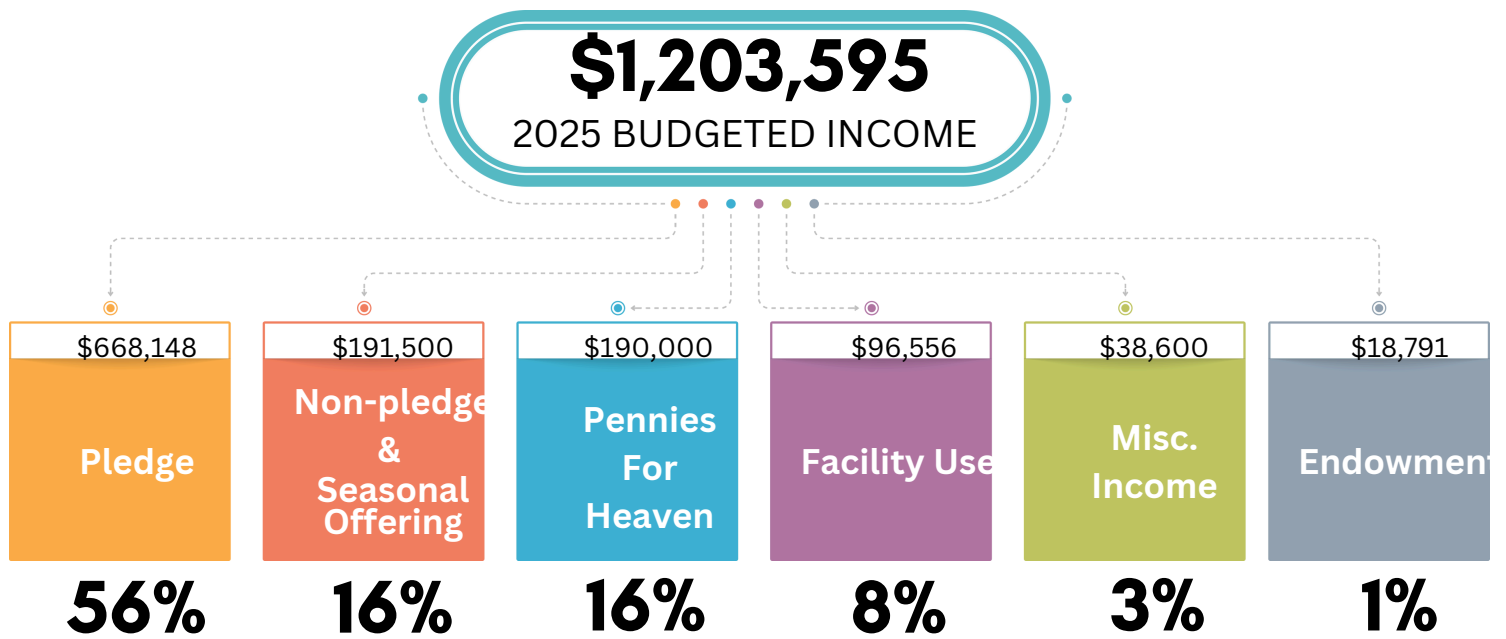
Clergy and Staff Salaries and Benefits: \$654,654

At the heart of all our programs and ministries are dedicated staff and clergy. Their creativity, passion, and commitment are the foundation on which we build ministry. 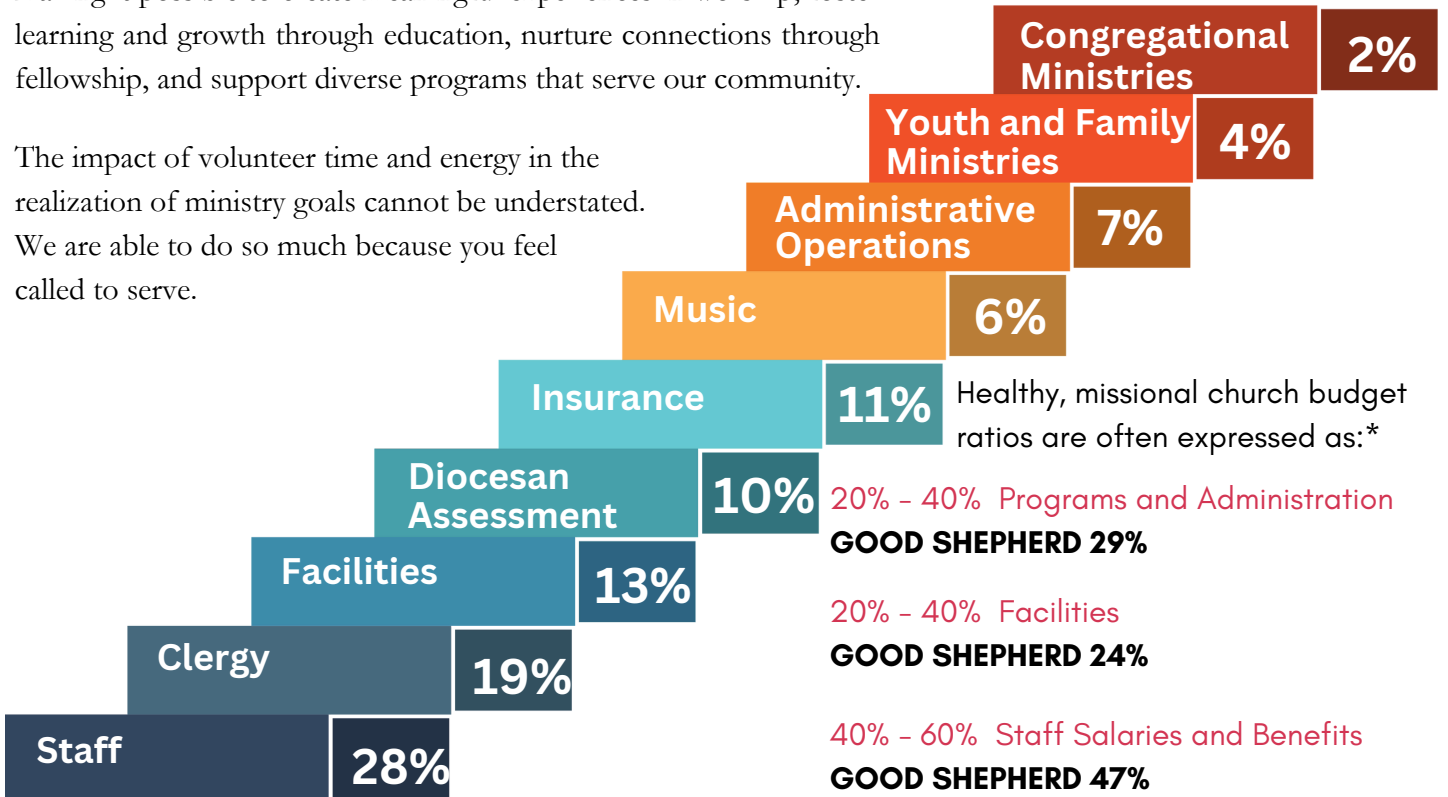
Number of Good Shepherd households that made a giving pledge for 2025

DESIGNATE AN ADDITIONAL GIFT

In addition to pledge, these **RESTRICTED FUNDS** enable us to tackle long-term projects and plans for future ministry:

Food Pantry - Provides emergency food for anyone who is hungry

Youth Ministry - Supports Youth Mission and Pilgrimage experiences not covered by operating account

Technology Fund - Enables us to keep up with rapidly changing technology requirements

Altar Guild - Provides for vestments, and elements to enhance worship

Music Fund - Supports special one-time music expenses/supplies and special guest performers

Building Maintenance Account - Enables upkeep and also funds emergency replacement/repair



Gifts to our **MANAGED FUNDS** transform generosity into action and action into meaningful change.

- **Endowment Fund:** Sustains the church's mission by generating annual support for operations and special projects, ensuring long-term stability. **\$667,086**
- **Mission and Ministry Development Fund:** Supports new initiatives and capital improvements, enabling us to expand our impact and adapt to future needs. **\$675,229**

Endowment Income Percentage transferred to our Operating Budget

Per the bylaws of our Endowment Fund, 3% of the year-end managed endowment account balance is used for operating expenses for the following year. When the fund grows, so does our revenue for the church's mission, providing a greater benefit to our operating budget and enabling more ministry. **\$18,791 1% of total budget**
