Cut the pieces as she tells you, preferably from cotton. I only used 2 pieces. No flannel. Because elastic is hard to find, I used ribbon. Skip the elastic pinning part.

Start by sewing two pieces right side together, leaving an opening to flip, clip the corners as she does and then flip.



Then iron.

Pin and sew the pleats as she says.

Take the ribbon and **attach it across the top and across the bottom having equal amount on both sides**. About 45" (so total 90" inches for each mask).

Tie both side ribbons together in a noose knot that way they can adjust on the their ear and only tie once in the back. (Make a loose knot in one ribbon, then thread the other one through and pull to a tie.)
