MUSIC NOTES

Our closing hymn, "The King of love my shepherd is," a paraphrase of the 23rd Psalm, was written by Sir Henry Williams Baker. Born in London in 1821, his degree and holy orders were from Trinity College, Cambridge. In 1851 he was presented to the vicarage of Monkland. Sir Henry wrote and edited many church hymns and prayers, working for "Hymns Ancient and Modern" a publication often referenced in *Music Notes*. Although this hymn is paired with other melodies, our hymnal matched it with the traditional Irish melody 'St. Columba.' It is often sung at funerals, including that of Diana, Princess of Wales, in 1997.
