Bowling Machine Use Agreement

Bowling Machines Are Dangerous – THINK SAFTEY AT ALL TIMES!

By commencing your booking, you and your fellow players agree to abide by these basic guidelines to ensure you and those around you have a safe net session. It is a condition of hire and those not adhering to this agreement may have their booking terminated.

You agree:

- 1. That at least one of the hirers is over the age of 18yrs
- 2. All batters must wear full protective equipment as for a match:
 - Batting Gloves
 - Pads
 - Cricket box where appropriate
 - Cricket helmet including face guard
 - Forearm Guard (if practicing short pitched deliveries)

3. All batters are over the age of 12yrs

- 4. That only the batter and the machine operator are in the net and all spectators are on the viewing platform
- 5. All users will take time to familiarise themselves with the machine and assimilate the speed and bounce of the delivery before delivering to a batter
- 6. The hire will not tamper with the machine or remove any screens or safety guards
- 7. That all adjustments of speed or length are done with the knowledge of the batter
- 8. Speed and length are set to suit the individual batter
- 9. Batters must clearly signal when ready before each ball is fed into the machine
- 10. **ONLY** bowling machine balls will be used in the machine
- 11. The hire will report any damage to the machine to: 07970491784
- 12. The hirer will satisfy themselves that the machine is safe before using it
- 13. The hire understands that is there is no first aider on site and that they are using the machine entirely at their own risk.
