General Safety Agreement

By commencing your booking, you and your fellow players agree to abide by these basic guidelines to ensure you and those around you have a safe net session. It is a condition of hire and those not adhering to this agreement may have their booking terminated.

Using the Bowling Machines are covered in a separate agreement

Parking

- 1. Players MUST Park on the right of the yard in the designated parking area
- 2. There may be lorry and forklift movements on the yard. Please be aware of these and take extra care when walking to the cricket centre.

!Please make sure children never go out on the yard unsupervised!

- 3. During evening and weekend session there may be a large amount of car movements on the yard.
- 4. Players and coaches only are allowed in the playing area. Spectators please use the viewing gallery.

Entering the Nets

- 1. Pad up in the padding up area provided NOT in the lane
- 2. Be aware of the ball at all times- make sure any players in the nets are finished before you enter
- 3. Do not enter the nets until your booking starts a loud bell will sound on every hour to indicate the start/end of a net session
- 4. Do not take your kit bags etc into the nets they can cause obstructions and a distraction which prevent people taking evasive action.

General Rules of Use:

- 1. Only appropriate rubber-soled, non-marking cricket shoes should be worn—no spikes, heels, or street shoes
- **2.** Ensure the lane does not become congested with balls and take time to clear previously bowled balls in between deliveries
- **3.** All rubbish and equipment must be cleared after use; nets must be left as found, including stumps placed correctly
- 4. Players under 16 must be supervised
- 5. No more than 6 players per lane

Batting

- 1. Be aware that the indoor nets provide a much faster batting surface than natural grass.
- 2. Players must wear the correct protective equipment at all times:
 - Pads
 - Thigh Pad
 - Gloves

- Helmet
- Box if appropriate
- Plus any extra padding depending on experience, speed of bowler etc.
- 3. Please do not wear jewellery or watches and ensure pockets are empty
- 4. When preparing to bat players must stand at the back of the net and keep eyes on the ball at all times
- 5. Be aware of what is happening in the adjacent nets; please wait for a safe moment to retrieve the ball

Bowling

- 1. Only one player shall bowl in any one net at any one time.
- 2. Those waiting to bowl must stand in a sensible position and watch the ball to avoid being stuck

First Aid

- 1. There is NO first aider on site
- 2. The First aid kit is by the entrance of the centre and includes instant ice packs
