

Tips for packing household items for courier delivery

Supplies Checklist

- Sturdy Boxes: Various sizes.

Best Practices

- Balance weight evenly; heavy items in small boxes.
- Wrap individual items in bubble wrap, secure with packing tape.
- Fill gaps with packing peanuts or crumpled paper to prevent movement.
- Seal and reinforce box seams with strong packing tape.
- Use clear, bold labels for contents and handling instructions.

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Fragile Items

Techniques:

- Individually wrap fragile items in bubble wrap, securing with tape.
- Place wrapped items in a smaller box, then inside a larger box lined with packing peanuts for double protection.

Dividers and Box Size:

- Use cardboard dividers for glassware and porcelain.
- Select boxes that allow minimal movement and snug fit.



Electronics

Original Packaging: Ideal for electronics, as it's tailor-made for the item.

Batteries and Cords:

- Remove batteries to prevent leakage.
- Coil cords and secure with ties, keeping them away from screens.



Clothes and Textiles

Rolling vs. Folding:

- Roll casual clothes to save space and avoid creasing.
- Use wardrobe boxes for dresses, suits, and formal wear.

Vacuum-seal Bags:

- Ideal for reducing the volume of bulky items like winter clothing and bedding.

Books:

- Lay flat to protect spines; heavier books at the bottom.

Waterproofing:

- Encase important documents in plastic sleeves or waterproof bags.

Pots and Pans:

- Nest pots and pans, padding each layer.
- Wrap sharp knives and utensils in packing paper, then a towel.

Securing Lids:

- Secure lids on pots and containers with tape or rubber bands.

Special Considerations

Odd Shaped Items:

- Disassemble parts like bike handles and pedals.
- Use bubble wrap generously on irregular shapes.

Musical Instruments:

- Store in hard cases with extra internal padding for shock absorption



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Additional Special Consideration Items

Artwork and Paintings:

- Wrap in acid-free paper or cloth to protect surfaces.
- Use sturdy, flat picture boxes and padding for frames.



Mirrors and Glass Items:

- Secure with masking tape in an 'X' shape to prevent shattering.
- Wrap in bubble wrap and use mirror boxes for extra protection.



Lamps and Lighting Fixtures:

- Disassemble if possible, wrap bases and shades separately.
- Use bubble wrap for the base and special lamp boxes for the shades.

Toys and Board Games:

- Secure game pieces in ziplock bags.
- Wrap toys in bubble wrap, especially if fragile or collectible.



Carpets and Rugs:

- Roll tightly and secure with straps.
- Wrap in heavy-duty plastic to protect from dirt and moisture.



Decorative Items and Knick-Knacks:

- Individually wrap each item in bubble wrap.
- Use compartmentalized boxes for smaller items.

Plants:

- Use sturdy plant boxes.
- Secure the pot and cover the soil to prevent spillage.
