**Rebuild Relationships:** Heal the historical divide between justice-involved individuals, law enforcement, and the broader community.

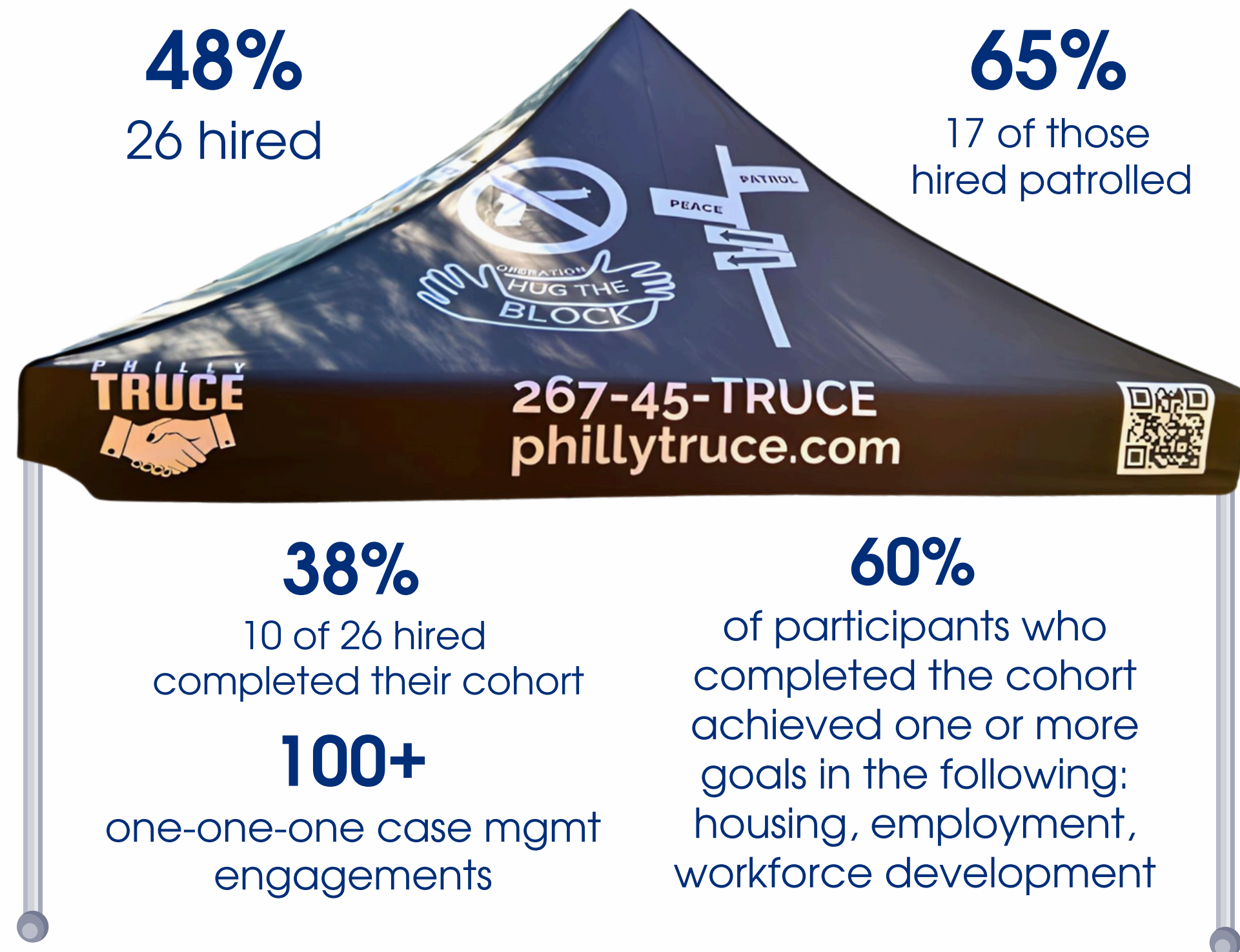

## GRADUATE STATS



*10 PEACE PATROL participants completed their cohort*

- 5 (50%) of participants were age 45 or older*
- Primary goals included: Employment, Housing, and Workforce Development*
- 6 (60%) had achieved at least one of their goals during participation in the program.*
- 6 (60%) had experienced incarceration personally*

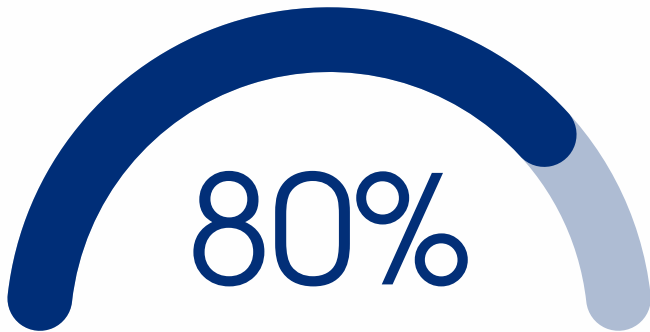

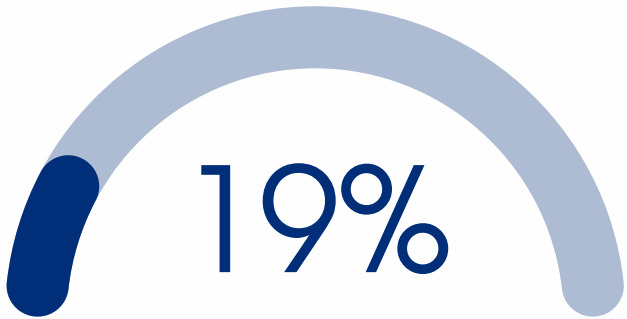

WERE BLACK

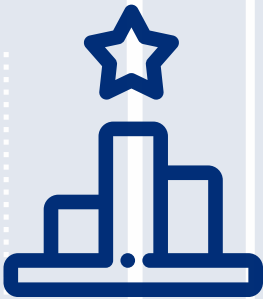
