Rules

- A horse and rider combo must declare their intent to compete for the grand championship title prior to the first class of the NWA National Championship Horse show.
- More than one rider may compete with the same horse; however, each horse and rider combo will compete as a team (multiple riders cannot combine points towards one award).
- Each team must declare a Western and English preliminary 2 gait class (ADP, CP, TP, LS, PLS, PP, SSH, Racking)
- If there is not a class offered for your division that is specified English/Western, you may choose an OT class. However, you must declare prior to the class that you will ride English or Western.
- If a novice class is offered in a division, you must declare what class you are choosing on your entry form
- Horse and rider combo with most points will be awarded the “All Around Versatility Grand Champion” Title, to be broken out by Adult and Youth winners.
