RE: Reinstatement of PHTLS and EPC Requirements

Effective Date: January 4, 2023, 0800 hrs.

- The requirement for Provisional Paramedics to have a current PHTLS and EPC certification prior to Capstone Testing and obtaining Certified Paramedic status was suspended due to the limitation of educational resources during the Covid19 pandemic.
- Effective January 4, 2023, the requirement for Provisional Paramedics to have a current PHTLS and EPC certification prior to participating in Capstone Testing will be reinstated.
- Pinellas County EMS will ensure there are sufficient PHTLS and EPC class offerings to meet this requirement.
