#### QCPR Quick Review

The CPRmeter 2 can display CPR performance statistics for the last CPR event. After the device is turned on, press the On/Off button briefly to activate QCPR Quick Review. The statistics are shown over two displays.

Press the On/Off button briefly to cycle between the Compression Feedback and QCPR Quick Review screens.

#### If the "Low Battery" indicator appears at shutdown:

If the "Low Battery" indicator appears at the bginning of use:

- 1. Continue use of the device during patient care
- 2. Remove device from service after the incident is completed
- 3. Set an ALERT in PSTrax for the specific asset
- 4. Replacement will be provided

If the "Customer Service" indicator appears at shutdown:

- 1. Immediately remove device from service
- 2. Set an ALERT in PSTrax for the specific asset
- 3. Replacement will be provided
