<p>The probability that a machine part or product will function properly for a specified time under stated conditions.</p>	<p>Reliability</p>
<p>The expected time between a repair and the next failure of a component, machine, process, or product.</p>	<p>Mean Time between Failures (MTBF)</p>
<p>The use of backup components or parallel paths to raise reliability.</p>	<p>Redundancy</p>
<p>A plan that involves monitoring, routine inspections, servicing, and keeping facilities in good repair.</p>	<p>Preventive Maintenance</p>
<p>Remedial maintenance that occurs when preventive maintenance fails and equipment/facilities must be repair on an emergency or priority basis.</p>	<p>Breakdown Maintenance</p>
<p>The failure rate early in the life of a product or process.</p>	<p>Infant Mortality</p>
<p>Operators partner with maintenance personnel to observe, check, adjust, clean, and notify.</p>	<p>Autonomous Maintenance</p>
