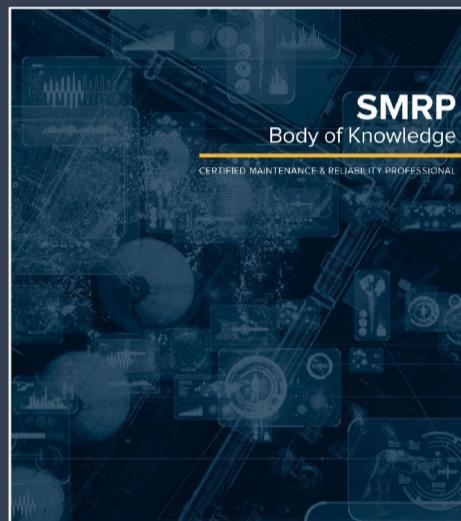
“Follow these steps if you plan to become a CMRP”

Step 1: Join SMRP (Cost \$170.00)

Step 2: Download the CMRP Candidate Guide for Certification and Recertification (Free on SMRP Website, you do not have to be a member to download), CMRP example questions are in this document

Step 3: As a member of SMRP download the following documents from the SMRP Website

- **SMRP Body of Knowledge (Critical to Know)**
 - Think about how this document could help you optimize your current Maintenance and Reliability at your site

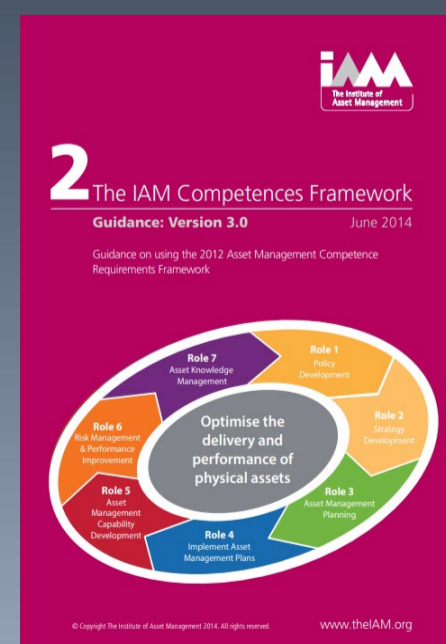
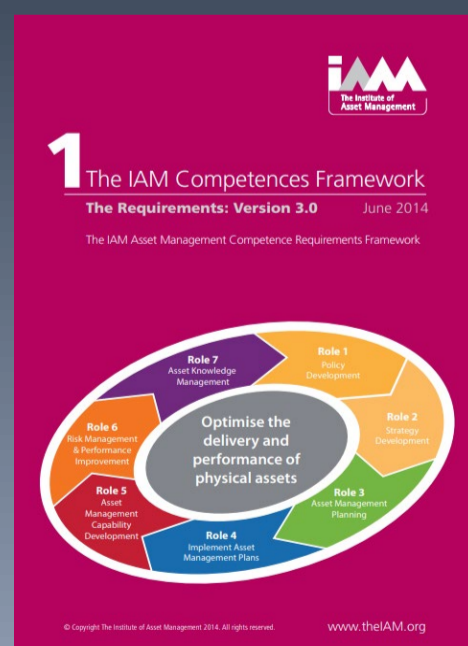
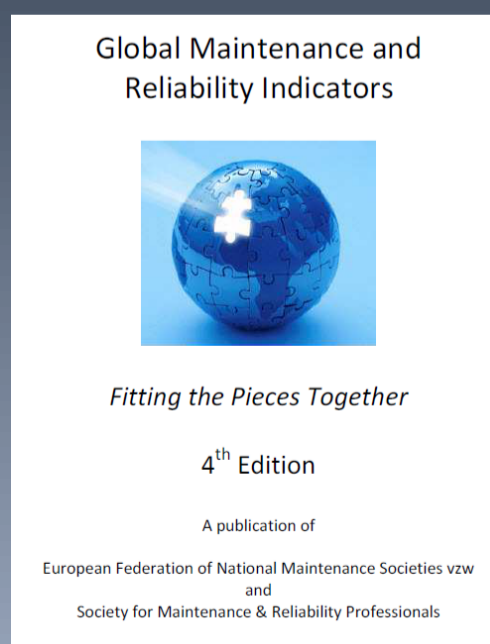


- **SMRP Best Practices (Critical to Know)**

- **Reliability Block Diagrams by Harry G. Kwatny**

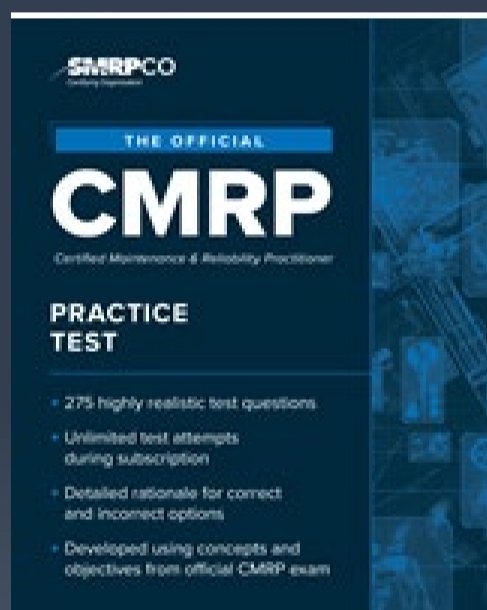


Step 4: Purchase the following books and study

- Create a Culture Change - Rules of Thumb for Maintenance and Reliability Engineers by Ricky Smith and Keith Mobley

Step 5: As a member of SMRP you can purchase practice test for the CMRP.

- The CMRP practice test questions are similar to questions on the exam to test your knowledge of the exam objectives.
- Detailed explanations for both correct and distractor answers reinforce the material
- Choose practice mode to prepare, or certification mode to determine exam readiness
- Review score reports in your learning locker
- The CMRP practice test includes 275 questions.

- Study for the CMRP 1 hour a day for 30 days
