

## The world is Digital

The Digital Scanner has rapidly became an important addition to the Lab and the range of work produced digitally is expanding. Virtually all metal crowns and copings are now scanned and milled or 3d printed. Zirconia crowns are now designed in house and can either be layered with porcelain for high aesthetic value or stained and glazed for those cases where strength is paramount. Zirconia is now available in more translucent shades meaning more natural restorations are available. We are now offering Implant restorations designed using the digital scanner which offers the opportunity for milled titanium abutments which are more cost effective than standard off the shelf abutments and allows for better emergence profiles and margin placement. We offer all the major Implants and this year have introduced bars in Titanium, CoCr, BioHpp and Pekkton Restorations are currently available using composite such as Visio-Lign and Twiny and later this year the BDT technique of placing Emax crowns and Nexco composite gumwork on Pekkton frames will be introduced following my attendance of the Course in November.

## Skool daze



March saw the long anticipated arrival of Nondas Vlachopoulos from Athens for his Masterclass in eMax anteriors. The photo above is my effort from this intense course and I have to admit that this was a watershed month for me, I learned more than at any time in my 36 years at the bench!

Geo Morgan gave a masterclass in the new hybrid composite Twiny which was illuminating into how far composites have developed and how important they will become in future prescriptions. Denturamics is now offering Twiny composite restorations and that should be of particular interest to any Surgeons restoring Bicon implants.

Julian Dorey was a Technician I had long wanted to see in action and November allowed me to attend his masterclass in Zirconia restorations. His teachings regarding shading in the incisal region will influence my work for the rest of my career.
