The Crown and Bridge Department will be closed from March 20th – 24th as I will be attending IDS in Cologne for the first time. The rapid changes in Dental Technology particularly in the Digital Field means that its vital to keep up and hopefully after a week at the show I should be up to speed with all the latest innovations.

One product I already know that will be launched is the Lisi Ingots from GC which according to my American friends has proved a step on from eMax.

3D printing is certainly making its presence felt and I will be looking at the latest advancements in this field as Resin models, Surgical Guides and BRA's are the current items to receive the 3D treatment successfully.

For those Surgeons who are restoring Implants I can announce that we are in the middle of acquiring machinery capable of producing high performance polymer frameworks in Pekkton. Zirconia and Co Cr frames can have problems with fractures long term leaving Surgery and Lab with the headache and expense of remakes or repairs . Those in the know are convinced that this is the future for implant retained Frames whether utilising Composite (BioHPP) or eMax crowns on Composite gumwork (BDT technique)

During 2016 I attended advanced courses on both systems and Denturamics is now accredited for both systems.

Ivobase

2016 saw many new products and machines come online with us including the acclaimed Ivobase denture injection system from Ivoclar. This system allows us to produce even better fitting and stronger Dentures due to the chemical shrinkage of the resin being entirely compensated during polymerisation. The result is a higher accuracy of fit than any high impact acrylic hitherto available.

All Private dentures will now be finished using the Ivobase system.(recent case pictured below)



The addition of our Digital scanner has revolutionised our Crown and Bridgework and recently we expanded into designing Implants and Milled bars with some amazing results. On March 9th I will be attending a course which will enable us to accept Intra-oral files from those Surgeries who have invested in a chair-side scanner.

We are now partnering with Createch in Spain who have merged with Straumann for our bigger milled cases and the precision from them is truly breathtaking.

The case pictured left is a -/F in Ivobase with metal housed riders on a Createch Milled bar which was constructed just last week.


